19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 11-6-110 is amended to read as follows:

22 11-6-110. Children under age ~~18~~ 17 years – Hours of employment.

23 ~~No boy or girl~~ A child under ~~the age of eighteen (18) years~~ seventeen
24 (17) years of age shall not be employed, or permitted, ~~or suffered~~ to work in
25 any occupation:

26 (1) More than six (6) days in any week;

27 (2) More than fifty-four (54) hours in any week;

28 (3) More than ten (10) consecutive hours in any one (1) day;

29 (4) More than ten (10) hours in a twenty-four-hour period; or

30 (5) Before 6:00 a.m. or after 11:00 p.m., except that the

31 limitations of 6:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. shall not apply to children under ~~the~~
32 ~~age of eighteen (18) years~~ seventeen (17) years of age employed on nights
33 preceding nonschool days in occupations determined by rule of the Department
34 of Labor to be sufficiently safe for their employment.
