## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REVISE THE HOURS OF EMPLOYMENT ALLOWED FOR CHILDREN UNDER SEVENTEEN (17) YEARS OF AGE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

 TO REVISE THE HOURS OF EMPLOYMENT ALLOWED FOR CHILDREN UNDER SEVENTEEN (17) YEARS OF AGE.BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 11-6-110 is amended to read as follows:
11-6-110. Children under age $18 \underline{17}$ years - Hours of employment.
No boy or girl A child under the age of eighteen (18) years seventeen (17) years of age shall not be employed, or permitted, or suffered to work in any occupation:
(1) More than six (6) days in any week;
(2) More than fifty-four (54) hours in any week;
(3) More than ten (10) consecutive hours in any one (1) day;
(4) More than ten (10) hours in a twenty-four-hour period; or
(5) Before 6:00 a.m. or after 11:00 p.m., except that the limitations of $6: 00 \mathrm{a} . \mathrm{m}$. and $11: 00 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$. shall not apply to children under the age of eighteen (18) years seventeen (17) years of age employed on nights preceding nonschool days in occupations determined by rule of the Department of Labor to be sufficiently safe for their employment.
