CONCERNING COUNTY RETENTION PRACTICES FOR
HOMESTEAD CREDIT LETTERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 13-4-303(2), concerning record retention practices for county tax and assessment records in the county assessor's office, is amended to read as follows:

(2)(A) For county assessor's records, maintain for five (5) years:

(i) Real estate appraisal card after reappraisal;

(ii) Lists of names of taxpayers furnished to assessor by school boards; ~~and~~

(iii) The personal, commercial, and industrial assessment forms; and

(iv) Inactive homestead credit documents.

(B) Prior to destruction of these forms, ~~they will~~ the documents shall be made available to the county collector;
