14	TO CREATE A PROGRAM FOR LICENSURE OF
15	COMMUNITY PARAMEDICS.
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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-13-202 is amended to read as follows:
21	20-13-202. Definitions.
22	As used in this subchapter:
23	(1) "Air ambulance" means an aircraft, fixed or rotary wing,
24	utilized for on-scene responses or transports deemed necessary by a physician
25	and licensed by the Department of Health;
26	(2) "Air ambulance services" means those services authorized and
27	licensed by the department to provide care and air transportation of
28	patients;
29	(3) "Ambulance" means a vehicle used for transporting any person
30	by stretcher or gurney upon the streets or highways of Arkansas, excluding
31	vehicles intended solely for personal use by immediate family members;
32	(4) "Ambulance services" means those services authorized and
33	licensed by the department to provide care and transportation of patients
34	upon the streets and highways of Arkansas;
35	(5) "Board" means the State Board of Health;
36	(6) "Council" means the Emergency Medical Services Advisory

1	Council;
2	(7)(5) "Emergency medical services" means:
3	(A) The transportation and medical care provided the ill
4	or injured before arrival at a medical facility by a licensed emergency
5	medical services personnel or other health care provider; and
6	(B) Continuation of the initial emergency care within a
7	medical facility subject to the approval of the medical staff and governing
8	board of that facility; and
9	(C) Integrated medical care in emergency and nonurgent
10	settings with the oversight of a physician;
11	$\frac{(8)(A)(6)(A)}{(6)(A)}$ "Emergency medical services personnel" means an
12	individual licensed by the department at any level established by the rules
13	adopted by the <del>board</del> <u>State Board of Health</u> under this subchapter and
14	authorized to perform those services set forth in the rules.
15	(B) These shall include without limitation EMT, Advanced
16	EMT, Paramedic, EMS Instructor, or EMS Instructor Trainer;
17	(9)(7) "Licensure" means official acknowledgment by the
18	department that an individual has demonstrated competence to perform the
19	emergency medical services required for licensure under the rules,
20	regulations, and standards adopted by the board upon recommendation by the
21	Emergency Medical Services Advisory Council; and
22	(10)(8) "Medical facility" means any hospital, medical clinic,
23	physician's office, nursing home, or other health care facility.
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25	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 13, is amended to add an
26	additional subchapter to read as follows:
27	<u>Subchapter 16 - Community Paramedics</u>
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29	20-13-1601. Definition.
30	As used in this subchapter, "Community Paramedic" means an individual
31	<u>who:</u>
32	(1) Is licensed as a paramedic;
33	(2) Meets the requirements for additional licensure as a
34	community paramedic under this subchapter; and
35	(3) Provides services to:
36	(A) Discharged inpatients who:

1	(i) Have been screened for home health or hospice;
2	<u>and</u>
3	(ii)(a) Do not qualify for home health or hospice
4	services; or
5	(b) Are documented as having declined home
6	health hospice services;
7	(B) Discharged emergency department patients; and
8	(C) Pre-hospital patients.
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10	20-13-1602. Community Paramedic — Licensure — Services.
11	(a) To be eligible for licensure by the Department of Health under the
12	Section of Emergency Medical Services as a Community Paramedic, an individual
13	shall:
14	(1)(A) Be currently licensed as a paramedic;
15	(B) Have two (2) years of full-time service as a
16	paramedic; and
17	(C) Be actively employed by a licensed paramedic ambulance
18	service; and
19	(2) Successfully complete a community paramedic training program
20	from an accredited college or university approved by the Department of Health
21	under the Section of Emergency Medical Services.
22	(b) The training program for the Community Paramedic shall consist of
23	a minimum of three hundred (300) hours of classroom and clinical education as
24	follows:
25	(1) Clinical experience that is provided under the supervision
26 	of a community paramedic service medical director, advanced practice
27	registered nurse, physician assistant, or home health nurse; and
28	(2) Areas of clinical experience including at a minimum:
29	(A) Emergency department services;
30	(B) Home health services;
31	(C) Hospital case management; and
32	(D) Public health agencies services.
33	(c) A community paramedic may provide services as directed by a
34	patient care plan after the plan has been developed, approved, or both by the
35 36	patient's physician in conjunction with the Community Paramedic service's
טע	medical director.

1	(d) An individual is an eligible patient for Community Paramedic
2	services if the individual has been identified by the individual's treating
3	physician as an individual for whom Community Paramedic services would
4	<pre>likely:</pre>
5	(1) Prevent admission to or allow discharge from a nursing
6	facility; or
7	(2) Prevent readmission to a hospital or nursing home.
8	(e) Community Paramedic services are limited to:
9	(1) Coordination of community services;
10	(2) Chronic disease monitoring and education;
11	(3) Health assessment;
12	(4) Hospital discharge follow-up care;
13	(5) Laboratory specimen collection; and
14	(6) Medication compliance.
15	(f) For purposes of relicensure a Community Paramedic shall:
16	(1) Complete an additional fifteen (15) hours training beyond
17	the relicensure requirements as a paramedic; and
18	(2) Be active in performing the skills of a Community Paramedic.
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20	20-13-1603 Rules.
21	(a) The Emergency Medical Services Advisory Council and the State
22	Board of Health shall adopt rules to implement this subchapter;
23	(b) The rules shall consider quality assurance and adequate data
24	collection to evaluate the utilization and effectiveness of the community
25	paramedic program.
