- 2 the President, upon authorization of the Board of Trustees, is allowed to
- 3 utilize the contingent positions contained in Section 1 of this Act, provided
- 4 he or she has obtained approval from the Department of Higher Education and
- 5 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, who has sought prior review by the
- 6 Arkansas Legislative Council.
- 7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2014
- 8 2015 through June 30, 2015 2016.

- 10 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
- 12 ALLOWANCES. The Board of Trustees of Arkansas Tech University may make
- 13 special allowances available to any coach who coaches more than one sport in
- 14 an amount not to exceed \$10,000 per fiscal year for any one coach. Further,
- 15 if the special allowance funds authorized herein are utilized, Arkansas Tech
- 16 University shall report annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee
- 17 the exact disposition of those special allowance funds.
- 18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, -2014
- 19 <u>2015</u> through June 30, <u>2015</u> <u>2016</u>.

- 21 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS
- 23 TECH INSTITUTE. The Arkansas Tech Institute (ATI) shall be administered
- 24 under the direction of Arkansas Tech University. Utilizing a
- 25 multidisciplinary collaboration of professionals, ATI shall explore, develop,
- 26 implement, and evaluate new and better ways to integrate the teaching, study
- 27 and performance of business, engineering, emergency management, and computer
- 28 sciences for academic, economic, and economic development purposes in
- 29 Arkansas. ATI priorities shall include, but are not limited to, economic
- 30 development, technology development, and "cyber-park" development. Arkansas
- 31 Tech University shall make annual reports to the Arkansas Legislative Council
- 32 on all matters of funding, existing programs, and services offered through
- 33 ATI.
- 34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2014}{1}$
- 35 <u>2015</u> through June 30, <u>2015</u> <u>2016</u>.

1	SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Dispursement of funds
2	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
3	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
4	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
5	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
6	Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
7	Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
8	State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
9	Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
10	with in disbursement of said funds.
11	
12	SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
13	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
14	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
15	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
16	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
17	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
18	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
19	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
20	
21	SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
22	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
23	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
24	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
25	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
26	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
27	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
28	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
29	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
30	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
31	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
