Monies deposited in the Court Awards Fund 32 each fiscal year may be used for motor vehicle purchases and associated taxes 33 and/or motor vehicle equipping and renovation costs, overtime, personal 34 services matching, agency operational needs and capital improvements for the 35 Department of Arkansas State Police. The provisions of this section shall be subject to prior review and approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

8 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 9 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 10 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 11 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 12 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 13 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 14 has determined that the Department of Arkansas State Police may operate more 15 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Arkansas 16 State Police authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is 17 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight 18 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 19 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the 20 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this 21 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 22 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent 23 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2014

27 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 29 PROVISION. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized, 30 after seeking the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to 31 request transfer from the appropriation made herein for "Confiscated Funds 32 Transfer" to the Overtime, Personal Services Matching, and Maintenance and 33 General Operations classifications established in the operations 34 appropriation of the Department of Arkansas State Police, and may be used for 35 overtime, personal services matching, motor vehicle purchases and associated 36 taxes and/or motor vehicle equipping/renovation costs, agency operational

needs and capital improvements for the Department of Arkansas State Police.
 Fund transfers may be requested from the Court Awards Fund to the Department
 of Arkansas State Police Fund in the same amount and for the same purposes as
 the appropriation transfer requested under the provisions of this section.
 The provisions of this section shall be subject to prior review and approval
 of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

7 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 8 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 9 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 10 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 11 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 12 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that the Department of Arkansas State Police may operate more 13 14 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Arkansas 15 State Police authorizing broad powers under this Section. SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

OVERTIME. 2 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to make overtime payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to 3 4 those officers or other employees that are currently assigned or may be 5 assigned by the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police to 6 Special Law Enforcement Task Forces and other special programs reimbursable 7 to Arkansas State Police by federal or local authorities as approved by the 8 Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police. All such overtime 9 payments shall be processed through the State Accounting System and shall be 10 in addition to the Regular Salaries and benefits accruing to the employee. 11 Payment of overtime is the preferred method of implementing the provisions of 12 this section.

33 SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 34 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 35 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 36 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

7 SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. 16 SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 17 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 18 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of 19 20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 21 22 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm 23 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 24 programs.
