20	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the	budget
21	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration,	letters, or
22	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas	Legislative
23	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and	adoption.

25	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by	the General
26	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibit	s the
27	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that	<u>the</u>
28	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the ope	ration of
29	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided,	and that in
30	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay i	n the
31	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irrepar	able harm
32	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governm	<u>ental</u>
33	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and	this Act
34	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peac	e, health
35	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July	1, 2015.
