1 authorized life or accident and health insurer, including licensed health 2 maintenance organizations, may apply for a credit for the noncommissioned 3 salaries and wages of the insurer's Arkansas employees which that are paid in 4 connection with its insurance operations. 5 (B)(i) The credit may be applied as an offset against the 6 premium tax imposed in § 26-57-603(d) on life and accident and health 7 insurance. 8 (ii) However, the credit shall not be applied as an 9 offset against the premium tax on collections resulting from an eligible 10 individual insured under § 20-77-2401 et seq. or § 23-61-801 et seq. 11 12 SECTION 30. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 26-57-13 610(b)(2), concerning the disposition of insurance premium taxes, is amended 14 to read as follows: 15 (2) The taxes based on premiums collected to implement the 16 private insurance option under the Health Care Independence Program 17 established by § 20-77-2405 and the Arkansas Health Care Independence Program 18 demonstration approved by the United States Department of Health and Human 19 Services on September 27, 2013, under § 20-77-2401 et seq. and § 23-61-801 et 20 seq. shall be: 21 (A) At the time of deposit separately certified by the 22 commissioner to the Treasurer of State for classification and distribution 23 under this section; and 24 (B) Transferred to the Health Care Independence Program 25 Trust Fund and used as provided by § 19-5-1141; 26 27 SECTION 31. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 28 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 30 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 32 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 33 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

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strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

1	SECTION 32. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
2	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
3	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
4	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
5	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
6	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
7	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
8	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

10	SECTION 33. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
11	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
12	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided; with the
15	exception that SECTION 28 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from
16	and after the date of its passage and approval and SECTIONS 29 and 30 shall
17	be in full force and effect from and after January 1, 2015, and that in the
18	event of an extension of the Legislative Session, the delay in the effective
19	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015, with the exception that SECTION 28 in
20	this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
21	passage and approval and SECTIONS 29 and 30 shall be in full force and effect
22	from and after January 1, 2015, could work irreparable harm upon the proper
23	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
24	an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
25	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
26	full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015; with the exceptions that
27	SECTION 28 in this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the
28	date of its passage and approval and SECTIONS 29 and 30 shall be in full
29	force and effect from and after January 1, 2015.
