| 26 | 17-95-903. Qualifications for licensure. |
| 27 | (a) Except as otherwise provided in this subchapter, an individual |
| 28 | shall be licensed by the Arkansas State Medical Board before the individual |
| 29 | may practice as a graduate registered physician. |
| 30 | (b) The board may grant a license as a graduate registered physician |
| 31 | to an applicant who: |
| 32 | (1) Submits an application on forms approved by the board; |
| 33 | (2) Pays the appropriate fees as determined by the board; |
| 34 | (3) Has successfully completed Step 1 and Step 2 of the United |
| 35 | States Medical Licensing Examination, Comprehensive Osteopathic Medical |
| 36 | Licensing Examination, or the equivalent of both steps of an Arkansas State |

| 1 | Medical Board-approved medically licensing examination within the two-year |
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| 2 | period immediately preceding application for licensure as a graduate |
| 3 | registered physician, but not more than two (2) years after graduation from a |
| 4 | medical school, an allopathic medical college, or an osteopathic medical |
| 5 | <pre>college;</pre> |
| 6 | (4) Has not completed an approved postgraduate residency but has |
| 7 | successfully completed Step 2 of the United States Medical Licensing |
| 8 | Examination or the equivalent of Step 2 from a board-approved medically |
| 9 | licensing examination within the two-year period immediately preceding |
| 10 | application for licensure as graduate registered physician; |
| 11 | (5) Has no licensure, certification, or registration under |
| 12 | current discipline, revocation, suspension, or probation for cause resulting |
| 13 | from the applicant's medical practice, unless the board considers the |
| 14 | conditions and agrees to licensure; |
| 15 | (6) Enters into a physician-drafted protocol within six (6) |
| 16 | months of initial licensure; |
| 17 | (7) Is of good moral character; and |
| 18 | (8) Submits to the board any other information that the board |
| 19 | deems necessary to evaluate the applicant's qualifications. |

| 21 | 17-95-904. Renewal. |
| 22 | (a) Upon notification from the Arkansas State Medical Board, an |
| 23 | individual who holds a license as a graduate registered physician in this |
| 24 | state shall renew the license by: |
| 25 | (1) Submitting the appropriate fee as determined by the board; |
| 26 | (2) Completing the appropriate renewal forms; |
| 27 | (3) Submitting verification of actual practice under a |
| 28 | physician-drafted protocol during the immediately preceding licensure period; |
| 29 | <u>and</u> |
| 30 | (4) Meeting other requirements set by the board. |
| 31 | (b) The Arkansas State Medical Board shall determine the renewal |
| 32 | period. |

| 34 | 17-95-905. Scope of authority. |
| 35 | (a)(1) A graduate registered physician may provide healthcare services |
| 36 | with physician supervision. |

| 1 | (2) The supervising physician shall be identified on all |
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| 2 | prescriptions and orders. |
| 3 | (3) A graduate registered physician may perform those duties and |
| 4 | responsibilities, including the prescribing, ordering, and administering of |
| 5 | drugs and medical devices, that are delegated by his or her supervising |
| 6 | physician. |
| 7 | (b) A graduate registered physician shall be considered the agent of |
| 8 | his or her supervising physician in the performance of all practice-related |
| 9 | activities, including but not limited to, the ordering of diagnostic, |
| 10 | therapeutic, and other medical services. |
| 11 | (c) A graduate registered physician may perform healthcare services in |
| 12 | a setting authorized by the supervising physician in accordance with any |
| 13 | applicable facility policy. |

| 15 | 17-95-906. Prescriptive authority. |
| 16 | (a)(l) A physician who is supervising a graduate registered physician |
| 17 | may delegate prescriptive authority to a graduate registered physician to |
| 18 | include prescribing, ordering, and administering Schedules III-V controlled |
| 19 | substances as described in the Uniform Controlled Substances Act, §§ 5-64-101 |
| 20 | - 5-64-510, and 21 C.F.R. Part 1300, all legend drugs, and all nonschedule |
| 21 | prescription medications and medical devices. |
| 22 | (2) All prescriptions and orders issued by a graduate registered |
| 23 | physician also shall identify his or her supervising physician. |
| 24 | (b) A graduate registered physician's level of prescriptive authority |
| 25 | shall not exceed the authority of the supervising physician. |
| 26 | (c) A graduate registered physician who prescribes controlled |
| 27 | substances shall register with the Drug Enforcement Administration as part of |
| 28 | the Drug Enforcement Administration's Mid-Level Practitioner Registry, 21 |
| 29 | C.F.R. Part 1300, 58 FR 31171-31175, and the Controlled Substances Act, 21 |

| 32 | 17-95-907. Supervision. |
| 33 | (a) Supervision of a graduate registered physician shall be continuous |
| 34 | and require the physical presence of the supervising physician at the place |
| 35 | that the services are rendered. |

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(b) Each team of physicians and graduate registered physicians has an

| 1 | obligation to ensure that: |
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| 2 | (1) The graduate registered physician's scope of practice is |
| 3 | identified; |
| 4 | (2) The delegation of a medical task is appropriate to the |
| 5 | graduate registered physician's level of competence; |
| 6 | (3) The relationship and access to the supervising physician is |
| 7 | defined; and |
| 8 | (4) A process of evaluation of the graduate registered |
| 9 | physician's performance is established. |
| 10 | (c) The graduate registered physician and supervising physician may |
| 11 | designate back-up physicians who agree to supervise the graduate registered |
| 12 | physician during the absence of the supervising physician. |
| 13 | (d) A physician who desires to supervise a graduate registered |
| 14 | physician shall: |
| 15 | (1) Be licensed in this state; |
| 16 | (2) Notify the Arkansas State Medical Board of his or her intent |
| 17 | to supervise a graduate registered physician; |
| 18 | (3) Submit a statement to the board that he or she will exercise |
| 19 | supervision over the graduate registered physician in accordance with rules |
| 20 | adopted by the board; and |
| 21 | (4) Limit supervision to no more than two (2) graduate |
| 22 | registered physicians per supervising physician. |

| 24 | 17-95-908. Notification of intent to practice. |
| 25 | (a)(l) Before initiating practice, a graduate registered physician |
| 26 | licensed in this state must submit on forms approved by the Arkansas State |
| 27 | Medical Board notification of an intent to practice. |
| 28 | (2) The notification shall include: |
| 29 | (A) The name, business address, email address, and |
| 30 | telephone number of the supervising physician; and |
| 31 | (B) The name, business address, and telephone number of |
| 32 | the graduate registered physician. |
| 33 | (b) A graduate registered physician shall notify the board of any |
| 34 | changes or additions in supervising physicians within ten (10) calendar days. |
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| 36 | 17-95-909. Exclusions of limitations of employment. |

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| 1 | This chapter shall not be construed to limit the employment arrangement |
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| 2 | of a graduate registered physician licensed under this subchapter. |
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| 4 | 17-95-910. Violation. |
| 5 | Following the exercise of due process, the Arkansas State Medical Board |
| 6 | may discipline a graduate registered physician who: |
| 7 | (1) Fraudulently or deceptively obtains or attempts to obtain a |
| 8 | <pre>license;</pre> |
| 9 | (2) Fraudulently or deceptively uses a license; |
| 10 | (3) Violates any provision of this subchapter or any rules |
| 11 | adopted by the board pertaining to this chapter; |
| 12 | (4) Is convicted of a felony; |
| 13 | (5) Is a habitual user of intoxicants or drugs to the extent |
| 14 | that he or she is unable to safely perform as a graduate registered |
| 15 | physician; |
| 16 | (6) Has been adjudicated as mentally incompetent or has a mental |
| 17 | condition that renders him or her unable to safely perform as a graduate |
| 18 | registered physician; or |
| 19 | (7) Has committed an act of moral turpitude. |

| 21 | 17-95-911. Disciplinary authority. |
| 22 | Upon finding that a graduate registered physician has committed an |
| 23 | offense described in § 17-95-910, the Arkansas State Medical Board may: |
| 24 | (1) Refuse to grant a license; |
| 25 | (2) Administer a public or private reprimand; |
| 26 | (3) Revoke, suspend, limit, or otherwise restrict a license; |
| 27 | (4) Require a graduate registered physician to submit to the |
| 28 | care, counseling, or treatment of a physician or physicians designated by the |
| 29 | board; |
| 30 | (5) Suspend enforcement of its finding and place the graduate |
| 31 | registered physician on probation with right to vacate the probationary order |
| 32 | for noncompliance; or |
| 33 | (6) Restore or reissue, at its discretion, a license and impose |
| 34 | any disciplinary or corrective measure that may have been imposed previously. |
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| 36 | 17-95-912. Title and practice protection. |

| 1 | An individual who is not licensed under this subchapter is guilty of a |
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| 2 | Class A misdemeanor and is subject to penalties applicable to the unlicensed |
| 3 | practice of medicine if he or she: |
| 4 | (1) Holds himself or herself out as a graduate registered |
| 5 | physician; or |
| 6 | (2) Uses any combination or abbreviation of the term "graduate |
| 7 | registered physician" to indicate or imply that he or she is a graduate |
| 8 | registered physician. |
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| 10 | 17-95-913. Identification requirements. |
| 11 | A graduate registered physician licensed under this subchapter shall |
| 12 | keep his or her license available for inspection at his or her primary place |
| 13 | of business, and when engaged in professional activities, a graduate |
| 14 | registered physician shall wear a name tag identifying himself or herself as |
| 15 | a graduate registered physician, and immediately below the licensure of |
| 16 | degree, information, in equal size or larger lettering. |

| 18 | 17-95-914. Rule-making authority. |
| 19 | The Arkansas State Medical Board shall promulgate rules that are |
| 20 | reasonable and necessary to implement this subchapter. |

| 22 | 17-95-915. "Good Samaritan" provision. |
| 23 | A graduate registered physician shall be subject to the "Good |
| 24 | Samaritan" provisions embodied in § 17-95-101. |
| 25 | |
| 26 | 17-95-916. Patient care orders. |
| 27 | (a) Patient care orders generated by a graduate registered physician |
| 28 | shall be construed as having the same medical, health, and legal force and |
| 29 | effect as if the orders were generated by his or her supervising physician, |
| 30 | provided that the supervising physician's name is identified in the patient |
| 31 | care order. |
| 32 | (b) The orders shall be complied with and carried out as if the orders |
| 33 | had been issued by the graduate registered physician's supervising physician. |
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| 35 | 17-95-917. Medical malpractice — Professional and legal liability for |
| 36 | actions. |

| 1 | A graduate registered physician shall be covered under the provisions |
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| 2 | regarding medical malpractice and legal liability as such applies to his or |
| 3 | her supervising physician as embodied in §§ $16-114-201-16-114-203$ and §§ |
| 4 | <u>16-114-205 - 16-114-209.</u> |
