12 (2) Without closure and post-closure care of landfills,
13 irreparable harm to human health and the environment will occur.

14 (b) Notwithstanding § 8-6-1001 et seq. and Acts 2014, No. 1202, § 41,
15 the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality also may:

16 (1) Expend monies from the Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund to a
17 state-approved contractor or the regional solid waste management district to
18 complete all actions necessary to achieve the final closure and post-closure
19 care of a landfill owned by a regional solid waste management district if the
20 department determines that the regional solid waste management district:

21 (A) Has filed for protection under federal bankruptcy law;

22 (B) Is unable to meet its debt obligations in the ordinary
23 course of its operations; or

24 (C) Is otherwise insolvent; and

25 (2) Institute a civil action against the regional solid waste
26 management district and all of the entities composing the regional solid
27 waste management district to seek the recovery of any funds expended from the
28 Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund under subdivision (b)(1) of this section,
29 unless satisfactory repayment arrangements are reached and agreed upon by the
30 department with the district and the bondholders.

31 (c) This section is in effect only from July 1, 2014, through June 30,
32 2017.

33
34 SECTION 44. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
35 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
36 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

1 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

7
8 SECTION 45. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

16
17 SECTION 46. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
18 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
19 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
22 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
23 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
24 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
26 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
27 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
