SECTION 34. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 10 EXTRA 11 HELP - HAZARDOUS WASTE PERMIT PROGRAM. There is hereby authorized, for the 12 Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality - Hazardous Waste Permit Program 13 for the 2014-2015 2015-2016 fiscal year, the following maximum number of 14 part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from 15 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: Four (4) temporary or part-time 16 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the 17 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the 18 appropriate classification. These four positions are utilized for a specific 19 project and are specifically exempt from the limitations, either by act or 20 regulation, of hours worked.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2014
22 <u>2015</u> through June 30, 2015 <u>2016</u>.

24 SECTION 35. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 26 EQUIPMENT PURCHASE RESTRICTIONS. Expenditures from the Hazardous Substance 27 Remedial Action Trust Fund for the purchase of departmental laboratory 28 equipment, including maintenance contracts, and data processing equipment and 29 mission-critical software, including maintenance contracts, as appropriated 30 in Section 13, in Items (03)(D) and (05) shall be funded only through 31 interest earnings from the Hazardous Substance Remedial Action Trust Fund. 32 Further, the Department shall report biennially to the Legislative Council 33 all expenditures from interest earnings for these purchases. 34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, -201435 2015 through June 30, 2015 2016.

1 SECTION 36. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. APPROPRIATIONS RESTRICTIONS. No expenditure from the Environmental Settlement 3 4 Trust Fund for information technology needs may be made without prior 5 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, after seeking review of 6 the Arkansas Legislative Council. Further, utilization of this appropriation 7 for information technology needs of the Arkansas Department of Environmental 8 Quality must also be approved by the Executive Chief Information Officer 9 after the project is evaluated on the methodology recommended by the Chief 10 Information Officer and the CIO Council, including an analysis of the return 11 on investment and linkage to the Department's business objectives. Any 12 approved projects and expenditures for information technology from the 13 Environmental Settlement Trust Fund shall be reported annually to the Joint 14 Committee on Advanced Communications and Information Technology.

18 SECTION 37. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ADEQ 20 ASBESTOS PROGRAM. The fees collected pursuant to Arkansas Code 20-27-1004(5) 21 shall be used by the department to fund operational expenses and to provide 22 and train personnel to administer an asbestos program, as funding is 23 available, including:

(a) Personnel dedicated to issue certificates and licenses to qualified 24 25 persons/companies, to perform audit of trainers, and to regularly update the 26 ADEQ web page providing a listing of asbestos licensed parties; 27 (b) Personnel who are trained as asbestos supervisors as defined by Arkansas 28 Code 20-27-1003 and Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission 29 Regulation No.21 to approve asbestos Notices of Intent, perform and 30 coordinate asbestos inspections, conduct enforcement actions, and provide 31 regulatory compliance information to assist the regulated community. Asbestos 32 inspectors shall have personal protective equipment when needed to enter a 33 regulated area; and 34 (c) Other personnel as necessary to administer the asbestos program.

The Department shall present the following data to Legislative Council quarterly, due by the 15th day of the month following the quarter:

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24 SECTION 39. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 26 TRANSFER PROVISION. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, 27 the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality may transfer from various 28 department funds to the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Fund 29 Account, the sum of \$1,500,000 in fiscal year 2014-2015 2015-2016, for the 30 exclusive purpose of supplementing funding for the appropriation provided in 31 Section 3. Appropriation - State Operations. The funds shall be used for 32 personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Department of 33 Environmental Quality - State Operations. Funds which remain in the Arkansas 34 Department of Environmental Quality Fund Account at the close of the fiscal year shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose for the 35 36 following fiscal year. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 5 6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING 7 REQUIREMENTS. For the purposes of the fund transfers provided for in Section 8 39 - Fund Transfer Provision, the amounts transferred shall not be considered 9 as part of any statutory limitation on the use of funds for administration of 10 programs of the Department. 11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 12 2015 through June 30, 2016. 13 14 SECTION 41. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LANDFILL 16 POST-CLOSURE CLEAN UP RESTRICTIONS. Any expenditures in excess of \$50,000 17 per site from the Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund, as appropriated in 18 Section 20, Item (04) for corrective action to remedy environmental impacts 19 of closed disposal sites previously operated as a landfill pursuant to state 20 law will be prioritized and authorized by the Commission after addressing 21 corrective actions needed to address environmental impacts from permitted 22 landfills closed properly. Expenditures exceeding \$2,000,000 per fiscal year 23 must be approved by the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission. 24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 25 2015 through June 30, 2016. 26 SECTION 42. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. NON 29 HAZARDOUS SITE CLEAN UP RESTRICTIONS. Expenditures from the Arkansas 30 Department of Environmental Quality Fee Trust Fund for the cleanup of non 31 hazardous sites which pose a threat to the environment, as appropriated in 32 Section 32, shall be funded only through interest earnings from the Arkansas 33 Department of Environmental Quality Fee Trust Fund. The Arkansas Department 34 of Environmental Quality shall seek cost recovery from parties responsible 35 for damages to the environment that dictate the use of appropriation 36 authorized in Section 32 of this act, as well as, any other funds spent by a

1 governmental entity to remediate such non hazardous sites. 2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. 3 4 SECTION 43. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE 5 6 ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 7 LANDFILL POST-CLOSURE TRUST FUND. 8 (a) The General Assembly finds that: 9 (1) A growing number of regional solid waste management districts 10 within the state are facing difficulty in funding the necessary costs of 11 closure and post-closure care of landfills owned by the districts; and 12 (2) Without closure and post-closure care of landfills, 13 irreparable harm to human health and the environment will occur. 14 (b) Notwithstanding § 8-6-1001 et seq. and Acts 2014, No. 1202, § 41, 15 the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality also may: 16 (1) Expend monies from the Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund to a 17 state-approved contractor or the regional solid waste management district to 18 complete all actions necessary to achieve the final closure and post-closure 19 care of a landfill owned by a regional solid waste management district if the 20 department determines that the regional solid waste management district: 21 (A) Has filed for protection under federal bankruptcy law; 22 (B) Is unable to meet its debt obligations in the ordinary 23 course of its operations; or 24 (C) Is otherwise insolvent; and 25 Institute a civil action against the regional solid waste (2) 26 management district and all of the entities composing the regional solid 27 waste management district to seek the recovery of any funds expended from the 28 Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund under subdivision (b)(1) of this section, 29 unless satisfactory repayment arrangements are reached and agreed upon by the 30 department with the district and the bondholders. 31 (c) This section is in effect only from July 1, 2014, through June 30, 32 2017. 33 SECTION 44. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 34 35 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 36 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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8 SECTION 45. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 16

17 SECTION 46. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 18 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 19 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 21 22 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 23 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm 24 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 26 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015. 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34
