6 Center to the Department of Human Services Grants Fund Account. The  
7 transferred funds shall be used to match federal funds used for supplemental  
8 Medicaid payments to Arkansas Children's Hospital.

9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
10 2015 through June 30, 2016.

11  
12 SECTION 75. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
14 INNOVATION AND PROJECT DEVELOPMENT FUND TRANSFERS. The Department of  
15 Information Systems is a cost recovery agency subject to the requirements of  
16 the United States Office of Management and Budget Circular A-87 Cost  
17 Principles for State, Local and Indian Tribal Government (A-87) and Cost  
18 Principles for Developing Cost Allocation Plans and Indirect Cost Rates for  
19 Agreements with the Federal Government Implementation Guide for the Office of  
20 Management and Budget Circular A-87 (ASMBC-10). To comply with these federal  
21 rules, it is necessary to establish an Innovation and Project Development  
22 appropriation and general revenue fund account within the Department of  
23 Finance and Administration Disbursing Officer for the Department of  
24 Information Systems. This fund shall be used for state enterprise innovation  
25 projects that would enhance the technology operations of the State that  
26 cannot be cost allocated to federal programs. The Department of Information  
27 Systems will maintain documentation for projects billed for these purposes.  
28 Fund transfers may be made from the General Revenue Fund Account, upon the  
29 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review of the  
30 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to reimburse the  
31 Department of Information Systems for the amounts billed.

32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
33 2015 through June 30, 2016.

34  
35 SECTION 76. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. WORK

1 FORCE 2000 DISTRIBUTION. After the amounts to be made available to the  
2 various technical institutes or comprehensive lifelong learning centers have  
3 been determined as set out in Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(A) and 26-51-  
4 205(d)(2)(B), such documents as may be necessary shall be processed so that  
5 funds may be transferred from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund to the  
6 State Treasury fund or fund account from which the technical institute or  
7 comprehensive lifelong learning center draws its general revenue support.  
8 Such funds as may be transferred shall not exceed 6.309% of the total funds  
9 available from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund during each fiscal year.

10 In the event that a technical college, community college or educational  
11 institution which receives support from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund  
12 as determined by law transfers from the Arkansas Technical College and  
13 Community College System for which Work Force 2000 Development Fund monies  
14 are determined by law, then the actual amount of support from the Work Force  
15 2000 Development Fund in the preceding fiscal year for such educational  
16 institution shall be made available irrespective of any other provision of  
17 law which sets out maximum levels of support from such fund.

18 The Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall submit a report for  
19 review to the Arkansas Economic Development Commission prior to July 1, ~~2014~~  
20 2015 of the proposed distribution of the increase in the amount of funds in  
21 the Work Force 2000 Development Fund as set out in Arkansas Code 26-51-  
22 205(d)(2)(C) in excess of those amounts collected and distributed prior to  
23 June 30, 2014. The funds distributed under Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(C)  
24 in excess of those amounts collected and distributed prior to June 30, 2014  
25 shall be used only for the operation, support, and improvement of  
26 occupational, vocational, technical, and workforce development programs. The  
27 distributions of funds under Arkansas Code 21-51-205(d)(2)(C) in excess of  
28 those amounts collected and distributed prior to June 30, 2014 shall not  
29 apply to proceeds allocated to schools, colleges and educational institutions  
30 under Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(A) and 26-51-205(d)(2)(B).

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~  
32 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

33  
34 SECTION 77. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
36 PROCEDURES – EXTRA HELP. In the event that there is not sufficient

1 appropriation provided for by the General Assembly for payment of Extra Help  
2 for any state agency for the period ending June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016, said agency  
3 may request a transfer from appropriations provided for Extra Help in Section  
4 2, Miscellaneous Transfers, herein, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the  
5 State, stating clearly the amount required. Upon approval of the Chief  
6 Fiscal Officer of the State, and after seeking prior review by the Arkansas  
7 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the State Auditor shall be  
8 notified as to the amount and the purposes for which said appropriation is to  
9 be made. The appropriation shall then be established upon the books of the  
10 Department of Finance and Administration and the State Auditor. Provided  
11 further, that if desired, said appropriation shall be supplemental to those  
12 regularly appropriated for such purposes by the General Assembly for the  
13 agency.

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~  
15 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

17 SECTION 78. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
18 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
19 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
20 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
21 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
22 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
23 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
24 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
25 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

26

27 SECTION 79. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
28 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
29 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
30 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
31 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
32 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
33 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
34 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

35

36 SECTION 80. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the

1 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
2 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
3 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of  
4 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
5 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
6 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm  
7 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
8 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
9 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
10 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.

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
