- 2 AUTHORIZED BURN CENTER. The Arkansas Children's Hospital may request the
- 3 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer the sum of not to exceed
- 4 \$1,000,000 each fiscal year from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account from
- 5 funds made available by this Act for the Arkansas Children's Hospital Burn
- 6 Center to the Department of Human Services Grants Fund Account. The
- 7 transferred funds shall be used to match federal funds used for supplemental
- 8 Medicaid payments to Arkansas Children's Hospital.
- 9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
- 10 <u>2015 through June 30, 2016.</u>

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12 SECTION 75. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 14 INNOVATION AND PROJECT DEVELOPMENT FUND TRANSFERS. The Department of
- 15 Information Systems is a cost recovery agency subject to the requirements of
- 16 the United States Office of Management and Budget Circular A-87 Cost
- 17 Principles for State, Local and Indian Tribal Government (A-87) and Cost
- 18 Principles for Developing Cost Allocation Plans and Indirect Cost Rates for
- 19 Agreements with the Federal Government Implementation Guide for the Office of
- 20 Management and Budget Circular A-87 (ASMBC-10). To comply with these federal
- 21 rules, it is necessary to establish an Innovation and Project Development
- 22 appropriation and general revenue fund account within the Department of
- 23 Finance and Administration Disbursing Officer for the Department of
- 24 Information Systems. This fund shall be used for state enterprise innovation
- 25 projects that would enhance the technology operations of the State that
- 26 cannot be cost allocated to federal programs. The Department of Information
- 27 Systems will maintain documentation for projects billed for these purposes.
- 28 Fund transfers may be made from the General Revenue Fund Account, upon the
- 29 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review of the
- 30 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to reimburse the
- 31 Department of Information Systems for the amounts billed.
- 32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
- 33 <u>2015 through June 30, 2016.</u>

35 SECTION 76. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. WORK

- 1 FORCE 2000 DISTRIBUTION. After the amounts to be made available to the
- 2 various technical institutes or comprehensive lifelong learning centers have
- 3 been determined as set out in Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(A) and 26-51-
- 4 205(d)(2)(B), such documents as may be necessary shall be processed so that
- 5 funds may be transferred from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund to the
- 6 State Treasury fund or fund account from which the technical institute or
- 7 comprehensive lifelong learning center draws its general revenue support.
- 8 Such funds as may be transferred shall not exceed 6.309% of the total funds
- 9 available from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund during each fiscal year.
- 10 In the event that a technical college, community college or educational
- 11 institution which receives support from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund
- 12 as determined by law transfers from the Arkansas Technical College and
- 13 Community College System for which Work Force 2000 Development Fund monies
- 14 are determined by law, then the actual amount of support from the Work Force
- 15 2000 Development Fund in the preceding fiscal year for such educational
- 16 institution shall be made available irrespective of any other provision of
- 17 law which sets out maximum levels of support from such fund.
- 18 The Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall submit a report for
- 19 review to the Arkansas Economic Development Commission prior to July 1, 2014
- 20 2015 of the proposed distribution of the increase in the amount of funds in
- 21 the Work Force 2000 Development Fund as set out in Arkansas Code 26-51-
- 22 205(d)(2)(C) in excess of those amounts collected and distributed prior to
- 23 June 30, 2014. The funds distributed under Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(C)
- 24 in excess of those amounts collected and distributed prior to June 30, 2014
- 25 shall be used only for the operation, support, and improvement of
- 26 occupational, vocational, technical, and workforce development programs. The
- 27 distributions of funds under Arkansas Code 21-51-205(d)(2)(C) in excess of
- 28 those amounts collected and distributed prior to June 30, 2014 shall not
- 29 apply to proceeds allocated to schools, colleges and educational institutions
- 30 under Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(A) and 26-51-205(d)(2)(B).
- 31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2014
- 32 2015 through June 30, 2015 2016.

- 34 SECTION 77. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
- 36 PROCEDURES EXTRA HELP. In the event that there is not sufficient

- 1 appropriation provided for by the General Assembly for payment of Extra Help
- 2 for any state agency for the period ending June 30, 2015 2016, said agency
- 3 may request a transfer from appropriations provided for Extra Help in Section
- 4 2, Miscellaneous Transfers, herein, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 5 State, stating clearly the amount required. Upon approval of the Chief
- 6 Fiscal Officer of the State, and after seeking prior review by the Arkansas
- 7 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the State Auditor shall be
- 8 notified as to the amount and the purposes for which said appropriation is to
- 9 be made. The appropriation shall then be established upon the books of the
- 10 Department of Finance and Administration and the State Auditor. Provided
- 11 further, that if desired, said appropriation shall be supplemental to those
- 12 regularly appropriated for such purposes by the General Assembly for the
- 13 agency.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2014
- 15 <u>2015</u> through June 30, 2015 <u>2016</u>.

- 17 SECTION 78. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 18 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 19 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 20 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 21 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 22 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 23 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 24 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 25 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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- 27 SECTION 79. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
- 28 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
- 29 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
- 30 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
- 31 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
- 32 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
- 33 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
- 34 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 80. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the

I	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits	
2	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the	
3	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of	
4	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in	
5	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the	
6	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm	
7	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental	
8	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act	
9	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health	
10	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.	
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
