- 35 PROCEDURES PER DIEM MATCHING. If there is not sufficient appropriation,
- 36 from funds deposited in the State Treasury or Cash Accounts of an agency, for

1 personal services, or personal services matching for any state agency for the 2 period ending June 30, 2015 2016, for State agencies that process payroll 3 through the Arkansas Administrative Statewide Information System for federal 4 and state tax reporting as necessary to comply with the payment of stipends 5 under United States Internal Revenue Code (IRC), 2001-Code-Vol, Sec 3401 and 6 Treasury Regulations 31.3401(c)-1(a) and 1.1402(c)-2(b), and others which 7 govern the reporting of income and payment of withholding and matching taxes 8 for personal services, the agency shall request a transfer from appropriation 9 provided for Personal Services and Personal Services Matching in the 10 appropriation for Various State Agencies - U.S. IRC and Treasury Regulations 11 herein, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, stating clearly the 12 amounts required for each item.
