30	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work in	reparable harm
31	upon the proper administration and provision of essential go	<u>vernmental</u>

33	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	peace, health
34	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after	July 1, 2015.
