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- 15 (c) A <u>private school student or</u> home-schooled student shall not
- 16 participate in interscholastic activities at a public school other than the
- 17 student's resident school.
- 18 (d) A resident school district may permit a <u>private school student or</u>
- 19 home-schooled student to participate in an interscholastic activity if:
- 20 (1) For the purpose of subsection (g) of this section, the
- 21 private school student or home-schooled student reports to the resident
- 22 school district within the first eleven (11) days of the fall or spring
- 23 semester of the resident school district; and
- 24 (2) The <u>private school student or home-schooled student</u>, or his
- or her parent, advises the principal of the resident school in writing of the
- 26 student's request to participate in the interscholastic activity before the
- 27 signup, tryout, or participation deadlines established for students enrolled
- 28 in the resident school.
- 29 (e) The principal of the resident school shall permit a <u>private school</u>
- 30 <u>student or</u> home-schooled student to pursue participation in an
- 31 interscholastic activity of the resident school if the student or the
- 32 student's parent:
- 33 (1) Before the signup, tryout, or participation deadlines
- 34 established for students enrolled in the resident school, provides to the
- 35 principal a notice of the student's desire to pursue participation; and
- 36 (2) Informs the principal in the notice that the student has

- demonstrated academic eligibility by obtaining:
- 2 (A) A minimum test score of the thirtieth percentile on
- 3 the Stanford Achievement Test Series, Tenth Edition, or another nationally
- 4 recognized norm-referenced test in the previous twelve (12) months; or
- 5 (B) A minimum score on a test approved by the State Board
- 6 of Education.
- 7 (f) If a private school student or home-schooled student's written
- 8 request to participate in the interscholastic activity is approved under this
- 9 section, the student:
- 10 (1) Although not guaranteed participation in an interscholastic
- 11 activity, shall have an equal opportunity to try out and participate in
- 12 interscholastic activities without discrimination; and
- 13 (2) Shall not participate unless he or she meets the criteria
- 14 for participation in the interscholastic activity that apply to students
- 15 enrolled in the resident school district, including:
- 16 (A) Tryout criteria;
- 17 (B) Standards of behavior and codes of conduct;
- 18 (C) The academic criteria under subdivision (e)(2) of this
- 19 section;
- 20 (D) Practice times;
- 21 (E) Required drug testing;
- 22 (F) Permission slips, waivers, and physical exams; and
- 23 (G) Participation or activity fees.
- 24 (g) A <u>private school student or</u> home-schooled student who participates
- 25 in an interscholastic activity may be:
- 26 (1) Required to be at school not more than one (1) period per
- 27 school day; and
- 28 (2) Transported by the resident school district to and from
- 29 interscholastic activities as the resident school district transports other
- 30 students who are enrolled in the resident school.
- 31 (h) A student who withdraws from an Arkansas Activities Association
- 32 member school to enroll in a private school or to be home-schooled shall not
- 33 participate in an interscholastic activity in the resident school district
- 34 for a minimum of three hundred sixty-five (365) days after the student
- 35 withdraws from the member school.
- 36 <u>(i) A private school student is not eligible to participate in an</u>

1	interscholastic activity at the resident school as provided under this
2	section if the private school where the student is enrolled offers the same
3	interscholastic activity opportunity.
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
