## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES  
9 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE RICH MOUNTAIN  
10 COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30,  
11 2016; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.  
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## Subtitle

14 AN ACT FOR THE RICH MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY  
15 COLLEGE APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2015-2016  
16 FISCAL YEAR.  
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
23 for the Rich Mountain Community College for the 2015-2016 fiscal year, the  
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

7 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for  
 8 the Rich Mountain Community College for the 2015-2016 fiscal year, the  
 9 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as  
 10 "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes:  
 11 eighty (80) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay  
 12 not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation  
 13 Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

15 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
 16 appropriated, to the Rich Mountain Community College, to be payable from the  
 17 Rich Mountain Community College Fund, for personal services and operating  
 18 expenses of the Rich Mountain Community College for the fiscal year ending  
 19 June 30, 2016, the following:

34 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 35 to the Rich Mountain Community College, to be payable from cash funds as  
 36 defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Rich Mountain Community College, for

1 personal services and operating expenses of the Rich Mountain Community  
 2 College for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the following:

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19 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 20 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 21 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 22 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 23 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 24 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
 25 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
 26 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
 27 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
 28 with in disbursement of said funds.

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30 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 31 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 32 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
 33 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 34 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 35 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 36 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

1 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 3 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 4 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 5 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
 6 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of  
 7 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
 8 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
 9 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm  
 10 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
 11 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
 12 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
 13 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.

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
