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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
23 Department of Community Correction for the 2015-2016 fiscal year, the
24 following maximum number of regular employees.

35 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMMUNITY

1 CORRECTION PROGRAMS LINE ITEM USES. After seeking and receiving approval of
2 the Governor and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and upon approval by the
3 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the
4 Department of Community Correction, as authorized by the Board of
5 Corrections, is authorized to use funds appropriated for "Community
6 Correction Programs" line item of the Operations - Special Revenue
7 appropriation provided in this Act to construct new or renovate existing
8 facilities to support the development of community correction facilities in
9 the state.

10 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
11 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
12 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
13 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
14 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
15 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
16 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more
17 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community
18 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both
19 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
20 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
21 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
22 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
23 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
24 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
25 this entire section is void.

29 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

31 VEHICLE PURCHASE PROVISION. The Department of Community Correction is hereby
32 authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for
33 Capital Outlay in Section 3 and Section 4 in this Act.

1 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PARKING
3 FEES. On July 1, of each year the Department of Community Correction shall
4 pay from the appropriation provided herein from non-general revenue, the
5 total amount appropriated for War Memorial Stadium Commission Parking
6 Services from Fees to the War Memorial Stadium Commission.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
8 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

9
10 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
12 PROVISION. Upon seeking and receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer
13 of the State and review and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or
14 Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the Department of Community
15 Correction is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line item
16 authorized in Section 3 and Section 4 of this Act to any other line item
17 authorized in Section 3 and Section 4 of this Act.

18 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
19 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
20 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
21 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
22 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
23 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
24 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more
25 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community
26 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both
27 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
28 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
29 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
30 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.

1 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

3 REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES. Upon determination by the Board of Corrections
4 that a reallocation of resources within the Department of Community
5 Correction and Department of Correction is necessary for the efficient and
6 effective operation of the departments, the Board, with approval of the
7 Governor and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
8 Committee, shall have the authority to instruct the department directors, to
9 request from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, a transfer of positions,
10 programs, funds, appropriations, and line-item appropriations within or
11 between existing and newly created divisions, offices, sections, or units of
12 the departments. If it is determined that the requested transfer should be
13 made, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall then initiate the necessary
14 transfer documents to reflect the transfers upon the fiscal records of the
15 State Treasurer, the State Auditor, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
16 and the Departments of Correction and Community Correction. Provided,
17 however, that the Board shall be limited to submitting no more than two
18 requests, encompassing a single purpose listed in this section, during any
19 fiscal year per department. Transfer authority shall further be limited to
20 no more than five percent (5%) of the total General Revenue and Special
21 Revenue appropriation, funding, and positions specific to each agency.
22 However, there shall be no transfers to or from the County Jail Reimbursement
23 Fund. A Reallocation of Resources Transfer shall be limited to the following
24 specific purposes:

- 25 a) Costs to open and operate temporary beds;
26 b) Payment of Debt Service;
27 c) Payment of Overtime Expenses;
28 d) Unanticipated increases for medical or private prison contracts;
29 e) Construction/renovation/equipping of new beds;
30 f) Deficits in Farm or Industry Program;
31 g) Losses not covered by insurance proceeds;
32 h) Costs of personnel for critical services or necessary to carry out the
33 mission of the agency.

34 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
35 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
36 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by

1 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
 2 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
 3 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
 4 has determined that the Department of Correction and the Department of
 5 Community Correction may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is
 6 provided to the Board of Corrections authorizing broad powers under the
 7 Reallocation of Resources provisions herein. Therefore, it is both necessary
 8 and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring
 9 prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as
 10 provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
 11 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
 12 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 13 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court jurisdiction, this entire
 14 section is void.

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
 16 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

17
 18 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HOLIDAY
 20 COMPENSATION. The Department of Community Correction is authorized to pay
 21 employees for up to ninety-six (96) hours of unused holidays exceeding a
 22 balance in the employee's holiday account of one-hundred fifty (150) hours
 23 following the end of the calendar year. Payments of unused holiday hours must
 24 be processed on or before June 1st in each fiscal year. Employees terminating
 25 employment from the Department of Community Correction will be eligible for
 26 all holiday pay accrued during the years of service. This request is
 27 contingent on approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State after the
 28 Director of the Department of Community Correction has verified that
 29 sufficient revenues are available to make such payments to employees in the
 30 following classifications:

9 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MEDICAL
 11 SERVICES - CONTINGENCY POSITIONS. If it has been determined by the Board of
 12 Corrections that the Department of Community Correction cannot continue a
 13 medical contract with a private provider and the Board deems it necessary to
 14 utilize Department staff to provide the required services, the Department is
 15 allowed, upon notification of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after
 16 seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 17 Committee, to utilize the contingent positions for medical services contained
 18 in this Act and make the appropriate transfers from the Professional Fees and
 19 Services line item contained in Section 3 of this Act to Regular Salaries,
 20 Personal Services Matching and various Maintenance and General Operations
 21 classifications. Further, the Department may utilize the service(s) of a
 22 state-based or national-based Professional Recruitment Service, or network,
 23 as may be necessary to recruit, fill, or maintain the occupancy of the
 24 positions stated herein.

25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
 26 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

27

28 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

 29 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMMUNITY
 31 CORRECTION PROGRAM LINE ITEM USES. The appropriations authorized under the
 32 line item established herein for "Community Correction Program" are to be
 33 used by the Department of Community Correction for establishment and
 34 operation of, to include construction, renovation, and contracting for
 35 establishment and operation of, residential and non-residential community
 36 correction programs such as, but not limited to, community correction

1 centers, drug, alcohol, and mental health treatments, intensive supervision,
2 restitution, and others as established and approved by the Board of
3 Corrections and as may be provided by law.

4 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~
5 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

7 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
9 AUTHORITY FOR UTILITY AND FUEL RATE INCREASE. In the event of a ten percent
10 (10%) increase in utility and fuel rates, the Department of Community
11 Correction is authorized to transfer from any line item in Section 3 - State
12 Operations to Operating Expense Item (05)(A) in Section 3 - State Operations
13 for support of the increase after receiving approval of the Chief Fiscal
14 Officer of the State. Prior to the utilization of the transfer authority a
15 report shall be made to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
16 Committee including justification for the transfer and the amount of
17 transfer.

18 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
19 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
20 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
21 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
22 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
23 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
24 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more
25 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community
26 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is
27 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight
28 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
29 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the
30 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this
31 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint
32 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent
33 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

1 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY
3 JAIL INVOICE SUMMARY. The Departments of Correction and Community
4 Correction, shall at a minimum and on a fiscal year basis, prepare and post
5 on the applicable agency web site, a monthly summary of county jail
6 reimbursement invoices prepared and forwarded to each county sheriff for
7 verification by the Departments and for payment from the County Jail
8 Reimbursement Fund. In addition, the report shall include a summary of
9 invoices returned by each county for payment for previous months within the
10 fiscal year, the amounts paid, and any balances owed. Each fiscal year-end
11 report shall be maintained on the web sites for a period of no less than
12 three (3) years.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
14 2015 through June 30, 2016.

15
16 SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
17 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
19 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
22 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
23 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

25
26 SECTION 21. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
27 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
28 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
29 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
30 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
31 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
32 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
33 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

34
35 SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
36 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits

1 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
2 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of
3 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
4 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
5 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
6 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
7 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
8 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
9 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.

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
