Payments of unused holiday hours must 8 be processed on or before June 1st in each fiscal year. Employees terminating 9 employment from the Department of Community Correction will be eligible for 10 all holiday pay accrued during the years of service. This request is 11 contingent on approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State after the 12 Director of the Department of Community Correction has verified that 13 sufficient revenues are available to make such payments to employees in the 14 following classifications:
