18	(3) A description of the level of coordination existing among		
19	the agencies and other entities of activities, programs and messages on		
20	managing, treating, or preventing all forms of diabetes and its		
21	<pre>complications;</pre>		
22	(4)(A) The development or revision of detailed action plans for		
23	battling diabetes with a range of actionable items for consideration by the		
24	General Assembly.		
25	(B) The plans shall identify:		
26	(i) Proposed actions to reduce the impact of		
27	diabetes, prediabetes, and related complications caused by diabetes;		
28	(ii) Expected outcomes of the actions proposed; and		
29	(iii) Benchmarks for controlling and preventing		
30	relevant forms of diabetes; and		
31	(5) The development of a detailed budget blueprint:		
32	(A) Identifying needs, costs, and resources required to		
33	implement the plan identified in subdivision (4) of this section; and		
34	(B) Including a budget range for all options presented in		
35	the plan identified in subdivision (4) of this section for consideration by		
36	the General Assembly.

3	The requirements of this subchapter are limited to the diabetes		
4	information, data, initiatives, and programs within each agency prior to th		
5	effective date of this subchapter unless there is available funding for		
6	diabetes in each agency that may be used for new research, data collection,		
7	reporting, or other requirements of this subchapter.		
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
