6 (4) All persons who are required to have their eyesight tested 7 prior to initial licensing or upon subsequent license renewal as provided for 8 in this chapter shall be charged an additional fee of one dollar (\$1.00) two 9 dollars (\$2.00) upon issuance of the license.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 27-16-801(h)(1), concerning the fee charged for issuance or renewal of Class D, Class M, or Class MD driver's licenses, is amended to read as follows:

(h)(1) In addition to the license fees imposed in subsections (a) and
(e) of this section, a fee of six dollars (\$6.00) twelve dollars (\$12.00)
shall be charged for the issuance or renewal of any Class D, Class M, or
Class MD license.

19 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 27-16-901(a)(1), concerning the expiration 20 and renewal of driver's licenses, is amended to read as follows:

(a)(1)(A) Except for the intermediate driver's license and the learner's license, every driver's license shall expire at the end of the month in which it was issued four (4) eight (8) years from its date of initial issuance unless the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall provide, by regulation, for some other staggered basis of expiration.

(B) A learner's license shall be issued for no more than a
two-year period and shall expire upon the driver's reaching sixteen (16)
years of age. Any person sixteen (16) years of age may apply for an
intermediate driver's license, provided that his or her driving record is
free of a serious accident and conviction of a serious traffic violation for
the most recent six-month period.

32 (C) An intermediate driver's license shall be issued for 33 no more than a two-year period and shall expire upon the driver reaching 34 eighteen (18) years of age and may be renewed at that time as a regular 35 driver's license for four (4) <u>eight (8)</u> years, so long as the intermediate 36 driver has been free of a serious accident and conviction of a serious

2	2 her eighteenth birthday.
