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- In order to carry out the provisions of <u>To implement</u> this subchapter, the Division of Aging and Adult Services of the Department of Human Services is authorized:
- (1)(A) To enter into agreements with and make program grants to community-based agencies for the purpose of establishing statewide implementation of the Older Worker Community Service Employment Program.
- (B) However, the division shall make no payments towards the cost of the program unless the division determines that the community-based agencies will adhere to the provisions of § 20-80-205 and the established regulations rules or policies related to the administration of this subchapter;
- 31 (2) To allow reasonable and appropriate administrative cost for 32 the total program, which in no event shall exceed the allowable percentage 33 limitation established for Title V Title III of the Older Americans Act, 45 34 CFR Part 1321; and
- 35 (3) To make, issue, and amend regulations <u>rules</u> and policies as 36 may be necessary to effectively carry out the provisions of this subchapter.
