13	(d)(1) Alternate testing procedures may be approved by the executive
14	director of an education service cooperative after consultation with the
15	parents of a home-schooled student.
16	(2) However, any costs associated with an alternate testing
17	procedure shall be the responsibility of the parents.
18	(e)(1)(A) Any student who refuses to participate in the testing
19	program or the alternate testing program required by this section has not met
20	the statutory prerequisites for home schooling and, as any other student,
21	shall be subject to the applicable Arkansas laws regarding truancy.
22	(B) After a student corrects any refusal to participate in
23	the testing program or the alternate testing program as determined by the
24	department and required by this subsection, the student shall be restored to
25	home school status after his or her parent or guardian has complied with all
26	requirements of § 6-15-503.
27	(2) This subsection shall not be applicable to any parent who
28	can present written acknowledgement that the child has been enrolled in a
29	public, private, or parochial school within thirty (30) days of the
30	administration of the state-mandated achievement test.

32	student who enrolls or reenrolls in the school district in order to determine
33	proper educational placement.
34	(2) Among other means of assessment, the local school district
35	shall utilize the norm-referenced test approved by the state board to assess

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1	indicated by the test results A local school district that chooses to assess
2	a home-school student who enrolls or reenrolls in the school district may use
3	the same assessment that the school district uses when a student who has

5	(g) (b) Any A home-schooled student who enrolls or reenrolls in a local
6	school district must shall attend classes for at least nine (9) months
7	immediately before graduation before the student can become eligible to
8	receive a high school diploma from the school district.
