18	(1) "Building inspection official" means an appointed or elected
19	federal, state, or local official with the executive responsibility to
20	coordinate building inspection in the jurisdiction in which an emergency or
21	event has occurred;
22	(2) "Law enforcement official" means an appointed or elected
23	federal, state, or local official with the executive responsibility to
24	coordinate law enforcement in the jurisdiction in which an emergency or event
25	has occurred;
26	(3) "Professional engineer" means a person licensed as an
27	engineer under a state's engineering licensure laws.
28	(4) "Public official" means a federal, state, or local elected
29	official with the executive responsibility in the jurisdiction in which an
30	emergency or event has occurred;
31	(5) "Public safety official" means an appointed or elected
32	federal, state, or local official with the executive responsibility to
33	coordinate public safety in the jurisdiction in which an emergency or event
34	has occurred; and
35 36	(6) "Registered architect" means a person licensed under a state's architectural licensure laws as a registered architect.

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2	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 30, Subchapter 1, is
3	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
4	<u>17-30-106. "Good Samaritan" law.</u>
5	A professional engineer who voluntarily without compensation other than
6	expense reimbursement, provides architectural, structural, electrical,
7	mechanical, or other design professional services related to a declared
8	national, state, or local emergency caused by an earthquake, hurricane,
9	tornado, fire, explosion, collapse, or other similar disaster or catastrophic
10	event, shall be subject to the provisions and protection of § 17-15-106.
