## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE MARKETING AND  
REDISTRIBUTION OF STATE PERSONAL PROPERTY; TO PROVIDE  
AN EXEMPTION FROM THE MARKETING AND REDISTRIBUTION  
LAWS FOR THE SALE OF PLANTS, ANIMALS, AND COMMODITIES  
OF PLANTS AND ANIMALS IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; AND  
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO PROVIDE AN EXEMPTION FROM THE  
MARKETING AND REDISTRIBUTION LAWS FOR THE  
SALE OF PLANTS, ANIMALS, AND COMMODITIES  
OF PLANTS AND ANIMALS IN CERTAIN  
CIRCUMSTANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-8-106(a), concerning the marketing and  
redistribution of state personal property, is amended to read as follows:

(a)(1) ~~The provisions of this section shall be applicable~~ This section  
applies only with respect to personal property and ~~shall not be interpreted~~  
~~to apply or to affect in any way~~ does not apply to or affect the disposition  
of surplus real property of the state.

(2) This section does not apply to the sale of plants, animals,  
or commodities of plants or animals by a public institution of higher  
education if the proceeds from the sale are used solely for agricultural  
research, extension, or teaching programs, including without limitation 4-H  
and Future Farmers of America programs.
