14	(2) Any other funds authorized or provided by law.		
15	(c) Moneys in the fund shall be used by the Treasurer of State as		
16	directed by the General Assembly, to be deposited into general revenues to		
17	offset the cost of tax relief measures, fee reductions, and tax refunds.		
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
