3	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 17-14-201(c)(1)(B), concerning the term of		
4	certain members of the Arkansas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board,		
5	is amended to read as follows:		
6	(B) The financial member representative, the senior		
7	citizen representative, and the consumer representative shall have three-year		
8	terms, and the Covernor may reappoint these positions biennially.		
9			
10	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
11	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the appointments by the		
12	Governor for membership to the Arkansas Appraiser Licensing and Certification		
13	Board are overdue; that the criteria for eligible members to the Arkansas		
14	Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board need clarification; and that this		
15	act is immediately necessary because the Governor needs to make several		
16	appointments to the Arkansas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board to		
17	allow the Arkansas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board to continue		
18	carrying out its duties. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and		
19	this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public		
20	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:		
21	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
22	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
23	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
24	bill; or		
25	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
26	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
