1	(3) Any remaining fund datances carried forward from year to

3	(4) Any other funds authorized or provided by law.
4	(c) The fund shall be used by the Arkansas State Highway and
5	Transportation Department to provide grants or loans to state agencies or
6	other entities seeking to improve rail service in the State of Arkansas under
7	the Arkansas Rail Development Grant Program, § 23-11-601 et seq.
8	(d) Moneys remaining in the fund at the end of each fiscal year shall
9	carry forward and be made available for the purposes stated in this section
10	in the next fiscal year.
11	(e) The department may retain up to ten percent (10%) of the moneys
12	deposited into the fund for the administration of the Arkansas Rail
13	Development Grant Program, § 23-11-601 et seq., and for other railroad-
14	related activities as determined by the Director of State Highways and
15	<u>Transportation.</u>
16	
17	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 23, Chapter 11, is amended to add an
18	additional subchapter to read as follows:
19	<u>Subchapter 6 - Arkansas Rail Development Grant Program</u>
20	
21	<u>23-11-601. Title.</u>
22	This subchapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Arkansas Rail
23	Development Grant Program".
24	
25	<u>23-11-602. Definition.</u>
26	As used in this subchapter, "rail improvement project" means the
27	construction, improvement, capital facility rehabilitation, or expansion of a
28	new or existing railroad structure, facility, or service, including without
29	limitation an intermodal facility or industrial park facility.
30	
31	23-11-603. Arkansas Rail Development Grant Program.
32	(a)(1) The Arkansas Rail Development Grant Program is established and
33	shall be used to provide financial assistance in the form of grants and loans
34	to one (1) or more of the following entities that seek to improve rail
35	service within the State of Arkansas through a rail improvement project:
36	(A) A local or regional planning program;

1	(B) A state, local, or regional economic development
2	organization;
3	(C) A city, county, or regional governmental unit; and
4	(D) A nonprofit organization.
5	(2) The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department
6	shall establish and administer the program.
7	(b) Eligible expenses that may be covered by the program include
8	without limitation the cost of the following:
9	(1) Acquiring a right-of-way;
10	(2) Constructing, improving, or renovating a loading facility;
11	(3) Repairing or replacing track;
12	(4) Constructing, improving, or renovating a building;
13	(5) Providing rail switching;
14	(6) Providing rail access;
15	(7) Providing necessary utilities;
16	(8) Acquiring and preserving rail;
17	(9) Preserving a rail corridor; and
18	(10) Meeting federal matching requirements.
19	(c) The goals of the program are to:
20	(1) Ensure that the needs for improving rail service are being
21	met;
22	(2) Provide funds for all aspects of rail service, including
23	without limitation infrastructure improvements, rail access, safety
24	investments, and intermodal services;
25	(3) Preserve rail access by acquiring rail to be abandoned or to
26	preserve a rail corridor where service has been discontinued;
27	(4) Reduce highway congestion by ensuring that rail service is
28	readily available to Arkansas communities located on or near a rail line; and
29	(5) Assist railroad companies, local units of government, and
30	nonprofit organizations in improving rail service.
31	(d)(l) An entity seeking funding under this section shall submit an
32	application for funding on the form required by the department.
33	(2) An application may be submitted at any time.
34	(3) The application required under subdivision (d)(l) of this
35	section shall include the following:
36	(A) The formal name of the applicant;

1	(B) A description of the proposed rail improvement	
2	<pre>project;</pre>	
3	(C) Evidence of need for the proposed rail improvement	
4	<pre>project;</pre>	
5	(D) A description of the benefits to be derived from the	
6	<pre>proposed rail improvement project;</pre>	
7	(E) If applicable, a drawing of the proposed rail	
8	improvement project outlining boundaries and major elements of the proposed	
9	rail improvement project;	
10	(F) A budget for the proposed rail improvement project,	
11	including a cost estimate for the proposed rail improvement project and how	
12	the costs will be allocated among various budgeting line items; and	
13	(G) Any other information required by the department.

15	23-11-604. Arkansas Rail Development Grant Program Advisory Committee.	
16	(a) There is established the Arkansas Rail Development Grant Program	
17	Advisory Committee to make recommendations to the Arkansas State Highway and	
18	Transportation Department regarding the selection of recipients for grants or	
19	loans under the Arkansas Rail Development Grant Program.	
20	(b) The recommendations made by the committee under this section are	
21	not binding on the department.	
22	(c)(1) The committee is composed of the following nine (9) members	
23	appointed by the Governor:	
24	(A) One (1) representative of Class I railroads;	
25	(B) One (1) representative of Class III railroads;	
26	(C) One (1) representative of the planning and development	
27	districts established under § 14-166-201 et seq.;	
28	(D) One (1) representative of regional mobility	
29	authorities created under the Regional Mobility Authority Act, § 27-76-101 et	
30	seq.;	
31	(E) One (1) representative of regional intermodal	
32	authorities created under the Regional Intermodal Facilities Act, § 14-143-	
33	101 et seq.;	
34	(F) One (1) representative of the Arkansas Waterways	
35	<pre>Commission;</pre>	
36	(G) One (1) representative of the Arkansas Economic	

1	beveropment Commission; and	
2	(H) Two (2) representatives of the public at large.	
3	(2)(A) The terms of the initial members appointed to the	
4	committee shall be as follows:	
5	(i) The members appointed under subdivisions	
6	(c)(l)(A), (D), and (G) of this section shall serve a two-year term;	
7	(ii) The members appointed under subdivisions	
8	(c)(l)(B) and (E) of this section and one (l) of the members appointed under	
9	subdivision (c)(l)(H) of this section shall serve a four-year term; and	
10	(iii) The members appointed under subdivisions	
11	(c)(l)(C) and (F) of this section and one (1) of the members appointed under	
12	subdivision (c)(l)(H) of this section shall serve a six-year term.	
13	(B) Successor members shall serve six-year terms, except	
14	that a person appointed to fill a vacancy resulting in an unexpired term	
15	shall serve only for the remainder of that unexpired term.	
16	(3) A vacancy on the board shall be filled by the Governor in	
17	the same manner as other appointments.	
18	(d)(1) The committee shall meet at the call of the Director of State	
19	Highways and Transportation.	
20	(2) The director shall call at least one (1) committee meeting	
21	each calendar year to solicit input on grant or loan awards from the Arkansas	
22	Rail Development Grant Program Fund.	
23	(e) A meeting of the committee may be held in person or via conference	
24	call to solicit input on funding grants or loans for rail improvement	
25	projects.	
26	(f) A quorum of the committee is five (5) members.	
27	(g) A quorum of the committee is required to formally make a	
28	recommendation for funding a grant or loan.	
29	(h) Members of the committee shall serve without compensation.	
30		
31	<u>23-11-605. Rules.</u>	
32	The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department shall	
33	promulgate rules to implement and administer this subchapter.	
34		
35	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 26-26-1616(a)(1), concerning the	
36	disposition of taxes and penalties collected from utilities and carriers, is	

1	amended to read as follows:
2	(a)(1) Except as provided in subsections $\frac{(e)}{(e)}$ and $\frac{(d)}{(c)-(e)}$ of this
3	section, all taxes and penalties collected under § 26-26-1614 shall be
4	deposited into the State Treasury as trust fund income to the credit of the
5	Ad Valorem Tax Fund.
6	
7	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 26-26-1616, concerning the disposition of
8	taxes and penalties collected from utilities and carriers, is amended to add
9	an additional subsection to read as follows:
10	(e) The taxes and penalties collected from railroad companies under §
11	26-26-1614 in excess of twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) shall be
12	deposited into the State Treasury and credited to the Arkansas Rail
13	Development Grant Program Fund to be used for the purposes stated in the
14	Arkansas Rail Development Grant Program, § 23-11-601 et seq.
15	
16	SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after January
17	<u>1, 2016.</u>
