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worker's weekly benefit amount shall be an amount equal to one-twenty-sixth (1/26) of his or her total average wages for insured work paid during the one (1) quarter of his or her base period in which the wages were highest four (4) quarters of his or her base period. SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 11-10-504(a), concerning the maximum benefits payable for purposes of unemployment, is amended to read as follows: (a) The For initial claims filed on or after the first day of the calendar quarter following the effective date of this act, the maximum potential benefits of any an insured worker in a benefit year shall be the amount equal to whichever is the lesser of: (1) Twenty-five (25) Twenty (20) times his or her weekly benefit amount; or (2) One-third (1/3) of his or her wages for insured work in his or her base period.
