2	amount for purposes of unemployment, is amended to read as follows:		
3	(a) An For initial claims filed on or after the first day of the		
4	calendar quarter following the effective date of this act, an insured		
5	worker's weekly benefit amount shall be an amount equal to one-twenty-sixth		
6	(1/26) of his or her total average wages for insured work paid during the one		
7	(1) quarter of his or her base period in which the wages were highest <u>four</u>		
8	(4) quarters of his or her base period.

10	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 11-10-504(a), concerning the maximum		
11	benefits payable for purposes of unemployment, is amended to read as follows:

14	potential benefits of $\frac{1}{2}$ an insured worker in a benefit year shall be the		
15	amount equal to whichever is the lesser of:		
16	(1) Twenty-five (25) <u>Twenty (20)</u> times his or her weekly benefit		
17	amount; or		
18	(2) One-third $(1/3)$ of his or her wages for insured work in his		
19	or her base period.
