Arkansas Code § 6-15-426(i)(1)(A) and (B), concerning 8 school improvement, are repealed. 9 (A) The use of public school funding under the Public 10 School Funding Act of 2003, § 6-20-2301 et seq., for the following: 11 (i) Instructional facilitators as that term is 12 defined by the state board; and 13 (ii) Alternative learning environments, professional 14 development, English-language learners, and national school lunch students 15 identifying specific: 16 (a) Educational strategies; 17 (b) Resources used, including tutors, teachers' 18 aides, counselors, social workers, and nurses; and 19 (c) Expenditures made from categorical funds 20 provided under § 6-20-2305(b); and (B) The implementation of programs for students whose 21 22 academic achievement is below proficient. 23 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-15-2201(c)(2), concerning the 24 25 implementation of a state system of school improvement and accountability, is 26 amended to read as follows: 27 (2) The department and the State Board of Education shall monitor 28 the development and implementation of the revised school improvement plan. 29 30 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-15-2202(b)(1)(B), concerning National 31 School Lunch Act funds and national school lunch student state categorical 32 funds in a school improvement plan, is repealed. 33 (B) A public school that accepts National School Lunch Act funds and national school lunch student state categorical funding under § 6-34 20-2305 shall report in the public school's comprehensive school improvement 35 36 plan the following:
