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14 TO PROVIDE FLEXIBILITY TO SCHOOL DISTRICT
15 IN SCHEDULING ART, MUSIC, AND PHYSICAL
16 EDUCATION.
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-16-130(a) and (b), concerning visual art
22 or music, are amended to read as follows:

23 ~~(a)(1) By no later than June 1, 2002, every public elementary school in~~
24 ~~the state shall provide instruction in visual art or music based on the state~~
25 ~~visual art and music frameworks for a period of not less than forty (40)~~
26 ~~minutes each calendar week of the school year.~~

27 ~~(2)(A) Every student in grades one through six (1-6) shall be~~
28 ~~allowed to participate in the visual art or music class required in this~~
29 ~~subsection.~~

30 ~~(B) Children with disabilities or other special needs shall~~
31 ~~be included in the visual art and music programs.~~

32 ~~(3) Prior to June 1, 2005, the instruction required by this~~
33 ~~subsection may be provided by a volunteer or by a licensed teacher.~~

34 ~~(4) The Department of Education shall provide a stipend of not~~
35 ~~less than one hundred dollars (\$100) per class to each school for the~~
36 ~~purchase of necessary supplies or equipment for the classes required by this~~

2 ~~(b)(1) By no later than June 1, 2005, every~~ A public elementary school
 3 in the state shall provide instruction for ~~no less than~~ at least forty (40)
 4 minutes ~~and no more than sixty (60) minutes, as determined by the~~
 5 superintendent of the school district, in visual art and ~~no less than~~ at
 6 least forty (40) minutes ~~and no more than sixty (60) minutes, as determined~~
 7 by the superintendent of the school district, in music based on the state
 8 visual art and music frameworks each calendar week of the school year or an
 9 equivalent amount of time in each school year.

10 (2)(A) Every student in grades one through six (1-6) shall
 11 participate in the visual art and music class required in this subsection.

12 (B) Children with disabilities or other special needs shall
 13 be included in the visual art and music programs.

14 (3) The instruction required by subdivision (a)(1) of this
 15 section shall be provided by a teacher licensed to teach art or music, as
 16 applicable.

17 (4)(A) The Department of Education shall provide a stipend of not
 18 less than one hundred dollars (\$100) per class to each school for the
 19 purchase of necessary supplies or equipment for the classes required by this
 20 subsection.

21 (B) Subdivision (a)(4)(A) of this section shall be
 22 contingent on the appropriation and availability of funding for that purpose.
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24 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-16-132(b)(1)(A), concerning physical
 25 education, is amended to read as follows:

26 (b)(1)(A) The physical education curriculum and physical activity
 27 requirements for every public school student who is able to participate are:

28 (i) Except as provided in subdivision (b)(1)(A)(ii)
 29 of this section, for students in kindergarten through grade six (K-6):

30 (a) ~~Sixty~~ At least forty (40) minutes and no
 31 more than (60) minutes, as determined by the superintendent of the school
 32 district, of physical education training and instruction each calendar week
 33 of the school year; and

34 (b) Ninety (90) minutes of physical activity
 35 each calendar week of the school year, which may include without limitation
 36 daily recess, physical education instruction in addition to the requirement

1 of subdivision (b)(1)(A)(i)(a) of this section, or intramural sports;

2 (ii) For students in grades five through eight (5-8)
3 who attend a public school organized to teach grades five through eight (5-
4 8), or any combination thereof, at least forty (40) minutes and no more than
5 sixty (60) minutes, as determined by the superintendent of the school
6 district, of physical education training and instruction each calendar week
7 of the school year or an equivalent amount of time in each school year, with
8 no additional requirement for physical activity; and

9 (iii) For students in grades nine through twelve (9-
10 12), one-half (1/2) unit of physical education as required for high school
11 graduation, with no additional requirement for physical activity.

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
