7	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
8	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that employers struggle to

10	the state's workforce is the most effective route to economic growth;
11	and that this act is immediately necessary because lost time in meeting
12	the business crisis may set Arkansas at a disadvantage in the regional
13	economy. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act
14	being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace,
15	health, and safety shall become effective on:
16	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
17	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the
18	Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the
19	Governor may veto the bill; or
20	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
21	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
