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27	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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29	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-27-114(c), concerning the rules adopted	
30	by the Board of Corrections to reimburse a county jail for housing a state	
31	inmate, is amended to read as follows:	
32	(c)(l) The Board of Corrections shall adopt regulations <u>rules</u> by which	
33	the Department of Correction or the Department of Community Correction may	
34	reimburse any county, which is required to retain an inmate awaiting delivery	
35	to the custody of either the Department of Correction or the Department of	
36	Community Correction for more than thirty (30) twenty-one (21) days or upon	

1	receipt of a correct sentencing order, whichever occurs first, for the actual
2	costs paid for any emergency medical care for physical injury or illness of
3	the inmate retained under this section if the physical injury or illness is
4	directly related to the incarceration and the county is required by law to
5	provide the emergency medical care for inmates in the county jail.
6	(2) The Director of the Department of Correction or his or her
7	designee or the Director of the Department of Community Correction or his or
8	her designee may accept custody of any inmate as soon as possible upon
9	request of the county upon determining that the inmate is required to have
10	extended medical care.
11	(3) Reimbursements for emergency medical care under this
12	subsection shall be subject to the prior approval of the emergency medical
13	care by the Department of Correction or the Department of Community
14	Correction.
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
