- 1 as is practical, the State Treasurer shall transfer and credit to the "90th
- 2 Session Projects Account" of the "General Improvement Fund", upon
- 3 certification of the amounts thereof by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 4 State, the following:
- 5 (a) all unobligated and unallocated monies remaining in the "General
- 6 Improvement Fund" on June 30, 2015 which are not required to finance projects

Of those moneys accruing to the 90th Session Projects 18 Account of the General Improvement Fund as set out in Section 2 of this Act, 19 the State Treasurer shall first set-aside two hundred three million, three 20 hundred ninety-eight thousand, ten dollars (\$203,398,010), and any previous set-aside remaining balance as made available by subsection (e) of Section 2 21 22 of this Act for the set-asides enumerated in subsection (a) of Section 3 of 23 this Act. Such funds set-aside as enumerated in Section 3 subsections (a)(1) through (a)(10) shall be fully funded by June 30, 2017. The Shared Mandatory 24 25 Obligations Set-Asides enumerated in Section 3 subsections (a)(1) through 26 (a)(10) shall be distributed from time to time in amounts as determined by 27 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. If it is determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State that funding made available for Section 3 28 29 subsections (a)(4) and (a)(7) through (a)(10) is not required at the full 30 amount authorized by this Act, then any portion of those funds may be transferred to the Rainy Day Set-Aside established by Section 3 subsection 31 (a)(11) of this Act. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall notify the 32 Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee of the release of 33 funds for projects enumerated in Section 3 subsections (a), (b)(3) and (d) 34 and any funds transferred to Section 3 subsection (a)(11) at the same time 35

that the Department of Finance and Administration is notified.

17	transfers, from time to time, for projects in the Executive Discretionary
18	Division authorized in subsection (d) of Section 3 of this Act, upon approval
19	by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.
20	
21	(b)(1)Then the Treasurer of State shall distribute twenty million
22	dollars (\$20,000,000) to the Legislative Division as set out in subsection
23	(c) of this Act, and twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) to the Executive
24	Discretionary Division as set out in subsection (d) of this Act. Funds made
25	available to the Executive Discretionary Division may be used for any project
26	or portion thereof enumerated within the Executive Discretionary Division but
27	not to exceed the amount set out in subsection (d) for the project. The Chief
28	Fiscal Officer of the State shall notify the Arkansas Legislative Council or
29	Joint Budget Committee of the Governor's released funds for projects at the
30	same time that the Department of Finance and Administration is notified. The

SECTION 6. DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS. (a) Expenditure of the funds authorized by the Ninetieth General Assembly in either the regular, fiscal or extraordinary session from the 90th Session Projects Account shall be made only upon documentation to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, in such form as deemed necessary, that all criteria or pre-conditions established in the appropriation act have been met or in the case of state agencies, and that a Method of Finance has been filed with the Office of Accounting in the Department of Finance and Administration, if required.

- 10 (b) Any matching funds as may be provided in law shall be certified to
