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- 8 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 17-86-102(10), concerning the definition of 9 sexual misconduct, is amended to read as follows:
- 10 (10) "Sexual misconduct" includes:
- 11 (A) A range of behavior used to obtain sexual
- 12 gratification against another's will, at the expense of another, without the
- 13 client's knowledge, engaging in sexual activity for profit, or a combination
- 14 of any of these activities; and
- 15 (B) Massage of the genitalia, anus, and, except under
- 16 specific circumstances, the breast; and
- 17 (C) Sexual activity with consent of a client or at the
- 18 request of a client; and

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- 20 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 17-86-103, is amended to read as follows:
- 21 17-86-103. Penalties.
- 22 (a) Any person who shall violate violates any of the provisions of
- 23 this chapter shall be found guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall
- 24 be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six (6)
- 25 months or by a fine not exceeding one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500),
- 26 or by both fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court.
- 27 (b) It shall be the duty of the prosecuting attorney in the county
- 28 where the violation occurs, upon request by the Arkansas State Board of
- 29 Massage Therapy, to initiate proper legal proceedings in a court of competent
- 30 jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of this chapter.
- 31 (c) Any person found guilty of violations of this chapter may be
- 32 <u>subject to emergency suspension or revocation of licensure dependent upon the</u>
- 33 findings.
- $\frac{(c)(d)}{(d)}$ The courts of this state having general equity jurisdiction are
- 35 vested with jurisdiction and power to enjoin the unlawful practice of massage
- 36 therapy and related techniques in a proceeding by the board or by any citizen

- l of this state in the county in which the alleged unlawful practice occurred
- 2 or , the county in which the defendant resides, or in Pulaski County. The
- 3 issuance of an injunction shall not relieve a person from criminal
- 4 prosecution for violation of the provisions of this chapter, but the remedy
- 5 of injunction shall be in addition to liability to criminal prosecution.

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- SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 17-86-203(e)(1), concerning the powers and duties of the Arkansas State Board of Massage Therapy, is amended to read as
- 9 follows:
- (e)(1) For purposes of this section, an applicant is not eligible to
- 11 receive or hold a license issued by the Arkansas State Board of Massage
- 12 Therapy if the applicant has pleaded guilty or nolo contendere to or been
- 13 found guilty of a felony or Class A misdemeanor or any offense involving
- 14 fraud, theft, or dishonesty, sexual misconduct, sexual solicitation, lewd
- 15 <u>behavior</u>, child abuse or molestation, statutory rape, sexual assault, human
- 16 trafficking, or other violent crimes.

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- SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 17-86-301(b), concerning exemptions to registration requirements under the Massage Therapy Act, is amended to read as follows:
- 21 (b) Exemptions: The following are exempt from the licensing 22 requirements of this chapter:
 - (1) Persons A person authorized by the laws of this state to practice medicine, osteopathy, podiatry, or physical therapy, and licensed physicians' assistants, licensed nurses, licensed physical therapy assistants, licensed acupuncturists, licensed midwives, and chiropractors are exempt from this chapter in so far as massage therapy practices are offered or instructed within the scope and under the provisions of licensure;
 - (2) <u>Persons A person</u> authorized by the board to present and instruct board-approved school curriculum or continuing education programs, or both, may present and instruct such board-approved curriculum and programs for payment and in the presentation and instruction may utilize practices defined in, but without being licensed or registered under, the provisions of this chapter; and
- 35 (3) The practice of massage therapy that is incidental to a 36 program of study by students enrolled in a licensed massage therapy school

1 approved by the board, and under direct supervision of a licensee employed as 2 an instructor at the school, is exempt from \ 17-86-311(a)(10); 3 (4) A person authorized by the laws of this state to practice as 4 a licensed esthetician and cosmetologist within his or her scope of practice; 5 and 6 (5)(A) A person engaged in the practice of using minimal touch 7 over specific points on the body to facilitate balance in the nervous system, 8 also known as Bowen therapy or Bowen technique, and is certified by a 9 professional organization or credentialing agency that: (i) Requires a minimum level of training, 10 11 demonstration of competence, and adherence to an approved scope of practice 12 and ethical standards; and 13 (ii) Maintains disciplinary procedures to ensure 14 adherence to the requirements of the organization or agency. 15 (B) The Arkansas State Board of Massage Therapy may verify 16 that a practitioner claiming an exemption under subdivision (b)(4) of this 17 section is certified by a professional organization or credentialing agency. 18 19 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 17-86-302, is amended to read as follows: 20 17-86-302. Sanitary requirements. 21 (a) It shall be unlawful for any a person or school to be licensed or 22 any a clinic to be operated under the provisions of this chapter unless the 23 following requirements are met and practiced: 24 (1) A sink for hand washing with hot and cold running water and 25 soap must be accessible; 26 (2) A restroom must be accessible; 27 (3) A towel or sheet that has been used by one (1) client may 28 not be used on another person unless the towel or sheet has been relaundered; 29 (4)(A) Anyone who has any infectious, contagious, or 30 communicable disease which that may be spread by airborne, droplet, contact, 31 or indirect methods and who is in contact with the public must not practice 32 until all risk of disease transmission is cleared. 33 (B) Any employee with such a disease must be immediately relieved from duty until all risk of disease transmission is cleared; 34 35 (5)(A) Anyone who has an open cut, burn, wound, or aggravated 36 skin condition, including without limitation broken or abraded skin that

1	cannot be covered by a linger cot or latex glove that poses potential health
2	risk to a client must not practice until all risk of disease transmission is
3	cleared.
4	(B) An employee with a condition described in subdivision
5	(a)(5)(A) of this section shall be immediately relieved from duty until all
6	potential health risks are cleared;
7	(5)(6) A school or clinic must be equipped with a massage table
8	or tables or a massage chair or chairs or equipped with such standard
9	equipment dictated by the practice engaged in as defined in § 17-86-102; and
10	$\frac{(6)}{(7)}$ A clinic or school must comply with all requirements of
11	the Department of Health, city ordinances, and state laws.
12	(b) Failure to comply with any of the requirements as set forth by this
13	section will be grounds for suspension or revocation of license.
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15	SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 17-86-303(b),(c), and (d), concerning fees
16	relating to licensure for a massage therapist, are amended to read as
17	follows:

18	examination and copies of transcripts and furnish additional information and
19	documents as may be required by the board or its appointee during the
20	inspection.
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22	SECTION 12. Arkansas Code § 17-86-306(f)(3), concerning the fees
23	associated with a massage therapy school, is amended to read as follows:
24	(3) $\underline{(A)}$ The annual renewal and inspection fee for each school
25	shall not exceed one hundred dollars (\$100).
26	(B) In case of a massage therapy school failing an
27	inspection, a reinspection fee of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) will be
28	charged.
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30	SECTION 13. Arkansas Code § 17-86-306, concerning a massage therapy
31	school, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:
32	(h)(l) A massage therapy school shall maintain factual records of the
33	first-time pass rates and fail rates on required board examinations of all
34	graduates of the program.
35	(2) The records shall be inspected each year.
36	(3) A massage therapy school that does not maintain a seventy-

1	live percent (75%) average lirst-time pass rate on board examinations may be
2	subject to probation, suspension, or revocation of licensure.
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4	SECTION 14. Arkansas Code § 17-86-307(c), concerning fees relating to
5	a massage therapy clinic and spa, is amended to read as follows:
6	(c) $\underline{(1)}$ The annual inspection fee for each clinic and spa shall not
7	exceed seventy-five dollars (\$75.00).
8	(2) In the case of a massage therapy clinic or spa failing an
9	inspection, a reinspection fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) will be
10	charged.
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12	SECTION 15. Arkansas Code § 17-86-307, concerning a massage therapy
13	clinic and spa, is amended to add additional subsections to read as follows:
14	(d)(1)(A) The owner of a massage therapy clinic or spa shall register
15	the business with the board and obtain a clinic license.
16	(B) The owner may or may not hold a massage therapy
17	<u>license.</u>
18	(C) However, a licensee with a revoked or suspended
19	license is not eligible for a clinic licensure.
20	(2) A massage therapy clinic or spa owned by a licensee with a
21	revoked or suspended license shall have the clinic licensure revoked or
22	suspended.
23	(e) A person maintaining an individual clientele, solo practice, or
24	acting as an independent contractor shall register with the board and obtain
25	an independent clinic licensure.
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27	SECTION 16. Arkansas Code § 17-86-308(a)(2), concerning reciprocity of
28	massage therapists, is amended to read as follows:
29	(2)(A) If the applicant's transcript or a copy of the
30	applicant's transcript is not obtainable from the original school, the
31	applicant shall submit a statement to explain why it may not be obtained.
32	(B) Other documentation of credentials may be submitted
33	and accepted for licensure at the discretion of the board.
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35	SECTION 17. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 86, Subchapter 3, is
36	amended to add additional sections to read as follows:

1	17-86-314. Probation.
2	(a) The Arkansas State Board of Massage Therapy may place a licensee
3	that has a suspended license on probation.
4	(b) The board may require the licensee on probation to:
5	(1) Report monthly in writing to the board on matters relating
6	to the probation;
7	(2) Limit practice of massage therapy to areas prescribed by the
8	board; or
9	(3) Continue or review professional education until the person
10	attains a degree of skill satisfactory to the board in the areas that are a
11	basis of probation.
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13	17-86-315. Active military duty licensure.
14	(a) If a licensee fails to renew timely his or her license because the
15	licensee is or was on active duty with the United States Armed Forces, the
16	licensee may renew the license by:
17	(1) Requesting renewal of the license before or after the
18	expiration by:
19	(A) The licensee;
20	(B) The licensee's spouse; or
21	(C)(i) The licensee's power of authority.
22	(ii) A copy of the power of authority documentation
23	shall be filed with the renewal form if the power of authority requests the
24	renewal;
25	(2) Completing the appropriate renewal form, including the
26	current address and telephone number for the individual requesting the
27	renewal; and
28	(3) Filing with the renewal form a copy of the official orders
29	or other official military documentation showing that the licensee is or was
30	on active duty.
31	(b) A licensee renewing under this section shall pay the applicable
32	renewal fee under § 17-86-309 but shall not pay a late renewal fee.
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
