19	SECTION 1. Arkan	nsas Code § 17-86-102(10), conc	erning the definition of
20	sexual misconduct, is amended to read as follows:		
21	(10) "Sexu	ual misconduct" includes:	
22	(A)	A range of behavior used to ob	tain sexual
23	gratification against another's will, at the expense of another, without the		
24	client's knowledge, eng	gaging in sexual activity for p	rofit, or a combination
25	of any of these activit	ies; and	
26	(B)	Massage of the genitalia, anus	, and, except under
27	specific circumstances,	the breast; and	
28	<u>(C)</u>	Sexual activity with consent o.	f a client or at the
29	request of a client; an	<u>nd</u>

31	SECTION 2. Arkan	nsas Code § 17-86-103, is amendo	ed to read as follows:
32	17-86-103. Penalties.		
33	(a) Any person w	vho shall violate <u>violates</u> any o	of the provisions of
34	this chapter shall be f	found guilty of a misdemeanor as	nd upon conviction shall
35	be punished by imprison	nment in the county jail for no	t more than six (6)
36	months or by a fine not	exceeding one thousand five h	undred dollars (\$1,500),

- 1 or by both fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the court.
- 2 (b) It shall be the duty of the prosecuting attorney in the county
- 3 where the violation occurs, upon request by the Arkansas State Board of
- 4 Massage Therapy, to initiate proper legal proceedings in a court of competent
- 5 jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of this chapter.
- 6 (c) Any person found guilty of violations of this chapter may be
- 3 subject to emergency suspension or revocation of licensure dependent upon the
- 8 <u>findings</u>.
- 9 $\frac{(c)}{(d)}$ The courts of this state having general equity jurisdiction are
- 10 vested with jurisdiction and power to enjoin the unlawful practice of massage
- 11 therapy and related techniques in a proceeding by the board or by any citizen
- 12 of this state in the county in which the alleged unlawful practice occurred
- 13 or , the county in which the defendant resides, or in Pulaski County. The
- 14 issuance of an injunction shall not relieve a person from criminal
- 15 prosecution for violation of the provisions of this chapter, but the remedy
- 16 of injunction shall be in addition to liability to criminal prosecution.

- 18 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 17-86-203(e)(1), concerning the powers and
- 19 duties of the Arkansas State Board of Massage Therapy, is amended to read as
- 20 follows:
- 21 (e)(1) For purposes of this section, an applicant is not eligible to
- 22 receive or hold a license issued by the Arkansas State Board of Massage
- 23 Therapy if the applicant has pleaded guilty or nolo contendere to or been
- 24 found guilty of a felony or Class A misdemeanor or any offense involving
- 25 fraud, theft, or dishonesty, sexual misconduct, sexual solicitation, lewd
- 26 <u>behavior, child abuse or molestation, statutory rape, sexual assault, human</u>
- 27 trafficking, or other violent crimes.

- 29 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 17-86-308(a)(2), concerning reciprocity of
- 30 massage therapists, is amended to read as follows:
- 31 (2)(A) If the applicant's transcript or a copy of the
- 32 applicant's transcript is not obtainable from the original school, the
- 33 applicant shall submit a statement to explain why it may not be obtained.
- 34 (B) Other documentation of credentials may be submitted
- 35 and accepted for licensure at the discretion of the board.

1	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 86, Subchapter 3, is		
2	amended to add additional section to read as follows:		
3	17-86-314. Active military duty licensure.		
4	(a) If a licensee fails to renew timely his or her license because the		
5	licensee is or was on active duty with the United States Armed Forces, the		
6	licensee may renew the license by:		
7	(1) Requesting renewal of the license before or after the		
8	expiration by:		
9	(A) The licensee;		
10	(B) The licensee's spouse; or		
11	(C)(i) The licensee's power of authority.		
12	(ii) A copy of the power of authority documentation		
13	shall be filed with the renewal form if the power of authority requests the		
14	<u>renewal;</u>		
15	(2) Completing the appropriate renewal form, including the		
16	current address and telephone number for the individual requesting the		
17	renewal; and		
18	(3) Filing with the renewal form a copy of the official orders		
19	or other official military documentation showing that the licensee is or was		
20	on active duty.		
21	(b) A licensee renewing under this section shall pay the applicable		
22	renewal fee under § 17-86-309 but shall not pay a late renewal fee.
