30	SECTION 1. Arkan	nsas Code § 2-38-502 is amended to	read as follows:

32	(a) A person mag	y capture or kill a feral hog only	as follows:	
33	(1) On pr	ivate land if the person is the lan	downer or lessee or	
34	has the permission of the landowner or lessee; and

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1	(ii) The person possesses a valid <u>resident</u> Arkansas		
2	hunting license and complies with Arkansas hunting regulations.		
3	(B) However, a certified law enforcement officer or a		
4	public employee engaged in the performance of his or her official duties is		
5	exempt from the requirement under subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section.		
6	(b) A person whose hunting license is revoked shall not take or kill a		
7	feral hog during the period of the revocation.		
8	(c) A feral hog captured by any means in accordance with under		
9	subsection (a) of this section shall be immediately:		
10	(1) Killed; or		
11	(2)(A) Permanently identified by eartag approved by the Arkansas		
12	Livestock and Poultry Commission and transported to a terminal facility that		
13	is certified by the commission.		
14	(B) A feral hog that is transported to a terminal facility		
15	under subdivision (c)(2)(A) of this section is exempt from any requirements		
16	for disease testing established by the commission.		
17	(C) The commission shall adopt regulations for the		
18	issuance of a certification permit for a terminal facility and the		
19	requirements for inspection of a terminal facility.		
20	(D) A terminal facility shall:		
21	(i) Maintain a record of each feral hog purchased,		
22	including without limitation the:		
23	(a) Name of the seller;		
24	(b) Date of the purchase;

36	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 2-38-504(a) and (b), concerning penalties		

1 for releasing hogs into the wild, are amended to read as follows: 2 (a) A person who knowingly releases or attempts to release a live hog upon public land upon conviction is guilty of an unclassified felony 3 4 misdemeanor and is subject to a fine of not less than one thousand dollars 5 (\$1,000) per hog nor more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per hog Θ 6 imprisonment not to exceed two (2) years, or both and revocation of his or 7 her hunting and fishing rights in the state for up to five (5) years. 8 (b)(1) A person who knowingly releases or attempts to release a live 9 hog on private property upon conviction is guilty of an unclassified misdemeanor and is subject to a fine of not less than one thousand dollars 10 11 (\$1,000) per hog nor more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per hog or 12 imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days, or both. (2) However, subdivision (b)(1) of this section does not 13 14 prohibit a person from: 15 (A) Introducing introducing a domestic hog for farm 16 purposes onto private property enclosed with a fence sufficient under § 2-39-17 101 et seq. and with permission of the owner or lessee of the property; or. 18 (B)(i) Continuing to operate a hog-hunting facility 19 established before August 16, 2013, if: 20 (a) The hog-hunting facility and operation meet the requirements imposed by the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry 21 22 Commission for animal identification, transportation, and quarantine; 23 (b) The hog-hunting facility and operation are 24 subject to periodic inspections by the commission; and 25 (c) The hog-hunting facility and operation are 26 certified by the commission as a terminal facility, as defined in § 2-38-27 502(c). 28 (ii) An owner or operator of a hog-hunting facility that is in operation before August 16, 2013, that does not meet the 29 30 requirements stated in subdivision (b)(2)(B)(i) of this section is prohibited from purchasing or transporting a live feral hog under this subchapter. 31 32 (iii) Except as provided in subdivision (b)(2)(B)(i) 33 of this section, a person is prohibited from establishing or operating a 34 business in which one (1) or more feral hogs are placed in one (1) or more 35 fenced enclosures, regardless of the size of the enclosure, for the purpose 36 of conducting a hog-hunting operation.

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2	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 2-38-504, concerning penalties for		
3	releasing hogs into the wild, is amended to add additional subsections to		
4	read as follows:		
5	(g) Any certified state law enforcement officer may write a citation		
6	for a violation under this section.		
7	(h) Fines collected under this section shall be deposited into the		
8	Game Protection Fund to be used for eradication efforts to eliminate feral		
9	hogs.		
10	(i) This section does not apply to the purchase, sale, receipt,		
11	possession, import, or transportation of a live feral hog that serves as a		
12	mascot for an institution of higher education.		
13			
14	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code Title 15, Chapter 42, Subchapter 1, is		
15	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:		
16	15-42-129. Resident feral hog depredation permit.		
17	(a) The Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission may issue a resident		
18	depredation permit for hunting and trapping feral hogs.		
19	(b) A person may obtain a depredation permit issued under this section		
20	by:		
21	(1) Applying to the commission;		
22	(2) Furnishing information required by the commission to verify		
23	eligibility; and		
24	(3) Paying the fee required under subsection (b) of this		
25	section.		
26	(c) A depredation permit issued under this section shall:		
27	(1) Be in the same form and contain the same information as		
28	other depredation permits issued by the commission; and		
29	(2) Contain any other information required by the commission.		
30	(d) A property owner or tenant shall not be required to obtain a		
31	depredation permit issued under this section to hunt or trap feral hogs on		
32	the private property owned by the owner or leased by the tenant.		
33	(e) The commission may promulgate rules to implement this section.
