27	(b)(1) The task f	orce shall consist of the following twelve (12)	
28	members:

1	(2) If a vacancy occurs on the task force, the vacancy shall be	
2	filled by the same process as the original appointment.	
3	(3) Legislative members of the task force shall be paid per diem	
4	and mileage as authorized by law for attendance at meetings of interim	
5	committees of the General Assembly.	
6	(c)(1) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall call the	
7	first meeting of the task force within thirty (30) days of the effective date	
8	of this act and shall serve as chair of the task force at the first meeting.	
9	(2) At the first meeting of the task force, the members of the	
10	task force shall elect from its membership a chair and other officers as	
11	needed for the transaction of its business.	
12	(3)(A) The task force shall conduct its meetings at the State	
13	Capitol or another site selected by the chair.	
14	(B) Meetings of the task force shall be held at least one	
15	(1) time every two (2) months but may occur more often at the call of the	
16	chair.	
17	(4) The task force shall establish rules and procedures for	
18	conducting its business.	
19	(5)(A) A majority of the members of the task force shall	
20	constitute a quorum for transacting business of the task force.	
21	(B) The task force may not take an action except by a	
22	majority vote at a meeting at which a quorum is present.	
23	(6) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall provide staff for	
24	the task force.	
25	(d) The purpose of the task force is to:	
26	(1) Study the advantages and disadvantages of realigning state-	
27	supported institutions of higher education;	
28	(2) Identify current redundancies that exist with the current	
29	structure of higher education in Arkansas;	
30	(3) Determine what mechanisms are currently available or could	
31	be available to provide cost savings to state-supported institutions of	
32	higher education and to students;	
33	(4) Improve accountability to and communications with the	
34	General Assembly; and	
35	(5) Review the structure of higher education systems in other	
36	states, identifying those states with efficient and successful systems.	

1	(e) On or before november 1, 2016, the task force shall fille a report
2	of the task force's activities, findings, and recommendations with the
3	Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President Pro Tempore of the
4	Senate, the Chair of the House Committee on Education, and the Chair of the
5	Senate Committee on Education.
6	(f) The task force shall expire on December 31, 2016.
