9	(a)(1) A law enforcement officer is required to complete a training
10	program of at least twenty (20) hours in each of the following areas before
11	being certified by the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and
12	Training under this subchapter:
13	(A) Investigation of and circumstances surrounding cases
14	involving domestic violence; and
15	(B) Investigation of and circumstances surrounding cases
16	involving child abuse.
17	(2) Practicum training is sufficient for the requirements under
18	subdivision (a)(1) of this section.
19	(b)(1) A certified law enforcement officer shall complete a
20	supplemental training program or other instructional course annually
21	concerning the investigation of and circumstances surrounding cases involving
22	domestic violence and child abuse.
23	(2) The supplemental training program or other instructional
