8	Upon the death of a fetus diagnosed with a fatal fetal condition which		
9	will results in death within three (3) months of birth or upon the death of a		
10	child previously diagnosed with a fatal fetal condition, a physician may		
11	distribute information regarding organ and tissue donation to the parent or		
12	parents of the fetus or child or to the legal guardian of the fetus or child.
