5	(b) The Child Death And Near Fatality Multidisciplinary Review		
6	Committee is created to include the following members:		
7	(1) The Director of the Division of Children and Family Services		
8	or his or her designee;		
9	(2) One (1) member to represent the Division of Children and		
10	Family Services Family Service of the Department of Human Services Worker		
11	Supervisor as designated by the Director of the Division of Children and		
12	Family Services of the Department of Human Services;		
13	(3) One (1) member to represent the Division of Children and		
14	Family Services of the Department of Human Services Investigations Supervisor		
15	as designated by the Director of the Division of Children and Family Services		
16	of the Department of Human Services;		
17	(4) The Commander of the Crimes Against Children Division of the		
18	Department of Arkansas State Police or his or her designee;		
19	(5) The Executive Director of the Arkansas Commission on Child		
20	Abuse, Rape and Domestic Violence or his or her designee;		
21	(6) The Director of the Children's Advocacy Centers of Arkansas		
22	<u>or his or her designee;</u>		
23	(7) The Director of the Arkansas State Court Appointed Special		
24	Advocates for Children Association or his or her designee;		
25	(8) The Director of the Team for Children at Risk and Arkansas		
26	Children's House of the Arkansas Children's Hospital or his or her designee;		
27	(9) The Director of the Dependency-Neglect Attorney Ad Litem		
28	Program or his or her designee;		
29	(10) The Director of the Office of Policy and Legal Services of		
30	the Department of Human Services or his or her designee;		
31	(11) The Director of the Office of the Prosecutor Coordinator or		
32	his or her designee;		
33	(12) One (1) member appointed by the chair of the House		
34	Subcommittee on Children and Youth of the House Committee on Aging, Children,

36	(13) One (1) member appointed by the Chief Justice of the		

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1	Arkansas Supreme Court; and		
2	(14) One (1) member appointed by the Governor.		
3	(c) The committee shall review all child deaths of children under		
4	eighteen (18) years of age who had contact with the Division of Children and		
5	Family Services of the Department of Human Services within twenty-four (24)		
6	months before death as determined by comparing records of deaths from the		
7	Division of Vital Records with information in the Children's Reporting and		
8	Information System.		
9	(d) The committee shall review all child near fatalities that have		
10	been reported through the child abuse hotline where the Division of Children		
11	and Family Services of the Department of Human Services had prior contact		
12	within twenty-four (24) months of the near fatality.		
13	(e)(l) The committee shall meet no less than one (l) time each quarter		
14	of the calendar year.		
15	(2) A majority of the members of the committee shall constitute		
16	a quorum for the transaction of business.		
17	(3) A vacancy arising among the appointed membership of the		
18	committee for reasons other than expiration of the regular terms for which		
19	the member was appointed shall be filled by appointment by the person who		
20	appointed the vacating member.		
21	(4) At the expiration of the term of the initial chair, the		
22	committee shall elect a chair who shall serve a one (1) year term.		
23	(f) The meetings shall be closed and information discussed at the		
24	meeting shall be confidential.		
25	(g) No other individual shall be allowed to attend or participate in a		
26	meeting unless a majority of the members vote to request the attendance of a		
27	non-committee member.		
28	(h) The Division of Children and Family Services of the Department of		
29	Human Services and the Crimes Against Children Division of the Department of		
30	Arkansas State Police shall provide the list of all child deaths and near		
31	fatalities to be reviewed and all records related to the child in physical or		
32	electronic format to the members of the committee no less than fourteen (14)		
33	<u>calendar days before a scheduled meeting.</u>		
34	(i) The Department of Human Services shall provide to the committee a		
35	summary of any internal child death or near fatality review with the actions		
36	and recommendations of the Department of Human Services.		

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1	(j) Materials and information provided to members of the committee		
2	shall not be disclosed except to the committee.		
3	(k) The committee shall produce an annual report that shall contain a		
4	summary of findings, actions taken by the Department of Human Services or		
5	others and recommendations to each branch of state government to improve		
6	practices and prevent future child deaths or near fatalities.		
7	(1) Each committee member may review the report and submit additional		
8	comments that shall be included as an addendum to the report.		
9	(m) The annual report produced by the committee shall be presented to		
10	the House Committee on Aging, Children and Youth, Legislative and Military		
11	Affairs and shall be made available on the public disclosure of child deaths		
12	and near fatalities website of the Department of Human Services.		
13	(n) A committee member shall not be reimbursed for expenses to travel		
14	to or participate on the committee.		
15	(o) The Department of Human Services shall provide office space,		
16	materials, and staff assistance to the committee.		
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18	SECTION 2, DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Within thirty (30) days of the appointment</u>		
19	of the appointed members of the Child Death And Near Fatality		
20	Multidisciplinary Review Committee, the Director of the Department of Human		
21	Services shall call the first meeting of the committee.		
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
