16		TO AMEND THE LAWS APPLICABLE TO CERTAIN
17		ENERGY EFFICIENCY CONTRACTS AND PROJECTS;
18		TO AMEND THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CAPITAL
19		IMPROVEMENT REVENUE BOND ACT; AND TO
20		AMEND THE GUARANTEED ENERGY COST SAVINGS
21		ACT.

24	BE IT ENACTED BY	THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
25		
26	SECTION 1.	Arkansas Code § 14-164-402(15), concerning the definition
27	of "qualified eff	iciency contract" under the Local Government Capital
28	Improvement Rever	ue Bond Act, is amended to add an additional subdivision to
29	read as follows:	
30		(J) To encourage the implementation of performance-based
31	efficiency project	ts that result in a high level of energy and efficiency
32	savings that can	be reasonably estimated before implementation, the issuer
33	may substitute th	te terms and conditions stated in subdivisions (15)(A)-(G) of
34	this section with	documentation that verifies that:
35		(i) The performance-based efficiency project results
36	in estimated effi	ciency savings that on an annual basis are equal to one

1	hundred thirty-five percent (135%) of the annual cost, including debt	
2	service, required to implement the performance-based efficiency project; and	
3	(ii) The estimated efficiency savings of the	
4	performance-based efficiency project have been reviewed and verified by a	
5	professional engineer, as defined in § 17-30-101, who is not affiliated or	
6	associated with the qualified efficiency engineering company.	
7		
8	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 19-11-1206(a), concerning guaranteed energy	
9	cost savings contract requirements, is amended to read as follows:	
10	(a) The following provisions are required in a guaranteed energy cost	
11	savings contract:	
12	(1) A statement that the state agency shall maintain and operate	
13	the energy cost savings measures as defined in the guaranteed energy cost	
14	savings contract; and	
15	(2) Either:	
16	(A) A guarantee by the qualified provider that:	
17	(A) (i) The energy cost savings and operational cost	
18	savings to be realized over the term of the guaranteed energy cost savings	
19	contract meet or exceed the costs of the energy cost savings measures; and	
20	(B) (ii) If the annual energy or operational cost	
21	savings fail to meet or exceed the annual costs of the energy cost savings	
22	measure as required by the guaranteed energy cost savings contract, the	
23	qualified provider shall reimburse the state agency for any shortfall of	
24	guaranteed energy cost savings over the term of the guaranteed energy cost	
25	savings contract+; or	
26	(B) Documentation by the state agency verifying that:	
27	(i) The energy cost savings measure:	
28	(a) Satisfies the definition of "energy cost	
29	savings measure" under § 19-11-1202(1)(A)(ii); and	
30	(b) Will result in estimated energy cost	
31	savings and operational cost savings that on an annual basis are equal to one	
32	hundred thirty-five percent (135%) of the annual cost, including debt	
33	service, required to implement the energy cost savings measure; and	
34	(ii) The estimated operational cost savings of the	
35	energy cost savings measure have been reviewed and verified by a professional	
36	engineer as defined in § 17-30-101 who is not affiliated or associated with	

1	the qualified provider for the project.

3	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 11, Subchapter 12, is		
4	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:		
5	19-11-1209. Evaluation of qualified providers.		
6	(a) To promote entrepreneurship and encourage increased fair and		
7	appropriate competition among qualified persons or businesses desiring to		
8	expand or enter the field of completing projects involving energy cost		
9	savings measures, the Arkansas Energy Office, for purposes of certifying		
10	qualified providers, shall give full and fair consideration to each energy		
11	efficiency and facility improvement project completed by a person or		
12	business, including without limitation all subcontractors and employees of		
13	the person or business, applying for certification as a qualified provider		
14	regardless of whether:		
15	(1) The project was completed under a guaranteed energy cost		
16	savings contract; and		
17	(2) The financing for the project was arranged or provided by		
18	the person or business.		
19	(b) The office shall evaluate and approve qualified providers, using		
20	the standards stated in § 19-11-1202 and this section, within ninety (90)		
21	days of submission by an applicant of information demonstrating that the		
22	applicant qualifies to complete energy cost savings measures as a qualified		
23	provider.
