12	(b) The task force shall be composed of the following sixteen (16)		
13	members:		
14	(1) One (1) senator appointed by the President Pro Tempore of

16	(2) Two (2) members of the House of Representatives appointed by		
17	the Speaker of the House of Representatives;		
18	(3) The Director of the Department of Health or his or her		
19	designee, serving as an ex-officio, nonvoting member;

2	(c) The terms of the legislative members of the task force shall		
3	expire on December 31, 2016.		
4	(d) Nonlegislative members shall serve at the pleasure of the		
5	organizations they represent.		
6	(e) Vacancies on the task force shall be filled in the same manner as		
7	provided for the initial appointment.		
8	(f) The chair shall be one (1) of the legislative members of the task		
9	force and shall be selected by the legislative members of the task force.		
10	(g) The task force shall meet as often as is deemed necessary by the		
11	chair.		
12	(h) The chair shall call the first meeting, which shall be held no		
13	later than sixty (60) days after July 31, 2015.		
14	(i) The members of the task force shall serve without compensation and		
15	shall not receive per diem, mileage, or stipends.		
16	(j) The task force shall receive staff support from the Bureau of		
17	Legislative Research.

19	20-15-2003. Task Force on Alpha-gal — Duties.		
20	(a) The Task Force on Alpha-gal shall make recommendations designed to		
21	improve and increase knowledge and treatment throughout the state for alpha-		
22	gal, especially for emergency room healthcare professionals.		
23	(b) The task force shall submit a report to the Legislative Council,		
24	the Senate Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor, and the House		
25	Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor no later than October 1, 2016.
