3 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

4 Assembly of the State of Arkansas that funding for public schools is the

1	obligation of the state; that ensuring adequate funding is provided is the
2	duty of the General Assembly; and that this act is immediately necessary to
3	ensure that funding is provided for the 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 school years
4	so that school districts can budget accordingly. Therefore, an emergency is
5	declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the
6	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
7	<u>on:</u>
8	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
9	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
10	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
11	<u>bill; or</u>
12	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
13	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
