2	or marriage, but who has a strong positive emotional tie to the child and has					
3	a positive role in the child's life, such as a godparent, neighbor, or family					
4	friend selected by the Division of Children and Family Services who:					
5	(A) Is not related to a child by blood or marriage; and					
6	(B) Has a strong, positive, and emotional tie or role as					
7	follows:					
8	(i) In the child's life; or					
9	(ii) In the child's parent's life if the child is an

14	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code \S 9-28-402(16), concerning the definition of					
15	"provisional foster home" for the Child Welfare Agency Licensing Act, is

18	than six (6) months by the Division of Children and Family Services of the					
19	Department of Human Services for a relative or fictive kin of a child in the					
20	custody of the Division of Children and Family Services of the Department of

22	(A) Determines that placement with the proposed fictive					
23	kin or relative is in the best interest of the child;
