- 25 (B) The salary of the district court judge and the salary
- 26 of the district court clerk shall be paid as follows:
- 27 (i) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by the City of

- 29 (ii) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by Chicot

- 31 (14) The Clark County District Court Clerk shall receive an
- 32 annual salary of not less than twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28,000) nor
- 33 more than thirty-eight thousand dollars (\$38,000), to be established annually
- 34 by the Clark County Quorum Court. Upon approval by the Clark County Quorum
- 35 Court, the Clark County District Court Judge may appoint one (1) deputy
- 36 district court clerk to receive a salary as established by the Clark County

- 1 Quorum Court;
- 2 (15)(A) The Clay County District Court Judge shall receive an
- 3 annual salary of not less than seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000) nor more
- 4 than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), to be paid, as well as other current
- 5 benefits, in equal monthly installments by Clay County.
- 6 (B) Fifty percent (50%) of the amount shall be reimbursed
- 7 by the City of Corning, the City of Piggott, and the City of Rector at
- 8 eighteen and one-half percent (18.5%), eighteen and one-half percent (18.5%),
- 9 and thirteen percent (13%), respectively, to the county treasury.
- 10 (C) The clerks of the respective district courts shall
- 11 receive an annual salary of not less than four thousand five hundred dollars
- 12 (\$4,500) nor more than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000), to be paid, as
- 13 well as other current benefits, in equal monthly installments by Clay County.
- 14 (D) Fifty percent (50%) of the amount shall be reimbursed
- 15 by the respective cities;
- 16 (16) The Cleveland County District Court Clerk shall receive an
- 17 annual salary of not less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) nor more
- 18 than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), as may be determined by the

- 20 (17) The Columbia County District Court Judge shall receive an
- 21 annual salary of not less than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) nor

- 24 approval of the governing bodies of the City of Magnolia and Columbia County;
- 25 (18) The Conway County District Court Judge shall receive an
- 26 annual salary of not less than thirty-two thousand five hundred dollars
- 27 (\$32,500) nor more than forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000). However, the
- 28 salary may be increased by such an amount as may be agreed to by the Conway
- 29 County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Morrilton by

- 15 shall be paid by the City of Fordyce and Dallas County in equal monthly
- 16 installments;
- 17 (22) The Desha County District Court Dumas Department Judge
- 18 shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-seven thousand five
- 19 hundred dollars (\$27,500) nor more than forty-five thousand dollars
- 20 (\$45,000). The clerk of the district court shall receive an annual salary of
- 21 not less than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000) nor more than thirty

- 11 salary of not less than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) nor more than
- 12 thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000). The annual salary for each clerk of
- 13 the district court shall be not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor
- 14 more than thirty-five forty thousand dollars (\$35,000) (\$40,000);
- 15 (27) The Fayetteville District Court Judge shall receive an
- annual salary of not less than eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) nor more
- than one hundred forty-five thousand dollars (\$145,000);
- 18 (28) The Franklin County District Court Charleston District
- 19 Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand dollars
- 20 (\$10,000) nor more than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000). The salaries and
- 21 costs may be set and the payment may be apportioned by agreement between the
- 22 governing body of the City of Charleston and the Franklin County Quorum
- 23 Court;
- 24 (29) The Franklin County District Court Ozark District Judge
- 25 shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-two thousand six
- 26 hundred dollars (\$22,600) nor more than thirty-five forty thousand dollars
- (\$35,000) (\$40,000). The salary and costs may be set and the payment thereof
- 28 of the salary and costs may be apportioned by agreement between the governing
- 29 body of the City of Ozark and the Franklin County Quorum Court;
- 30 (30)(A) The Fulton County District Court Judge shall receive an
- 31 annual salary of not less than twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000) nor more
- 32 than thirty-two thousand dollars (\$32,000). The annual salary of the Fulton
- 33 County District Court Clerk shall be not less than fifteen thousand three
- 34 hundred dollars (\$15,300) nor more than twenty-two thousand dollars
- 35 (\$22,000).
- 36 (B) The expense of salaries, along with all other

- 1 necessary and customary expenses of the court, shall be shared by Fulton
- 2 County, the City of Salem, and the City of Mammoth Spring, based on a
- 3 percentage of the actual number of cases handled through the court for each
- 4 governmental entity. The percentage shall be determined annually by dividing
- 5 the total number of cases handled by the district court into the number of
- 6 cases handled annually for each of the aforementioned governmental entities.
- 7 On January 1 of each year, each share shall be estimated based on the number
- 8 of cases handled by the district court for each of the respective
- 9 governmental entities for the preceding year. However, on December 31 of each
- 10 year, each share shall be adjusted to reflect the actual percentage for each
- 11 governmental entity for that year based on the actual case load.
- 12 (C) The salaries and expenses shall be paid in equal
- 13 monthly installments by Fulton County, and the City of Salem and the City of
- 14 Mammoth Spring shall reimburse the county on a monthly basis for their
- 15 respective shares of salaries and expenses;
- 16 (31) The Garland County District Court Judges, Departments 1 and
- 17 2, shall receive an annual salary of not less than sixty-five thousand
- dollars (\$65,000) nor more than eighty-six ninety-five thousand dollars
- (\$86,000) (\$95,000), and the Garland County District Court Clerk shall

- 26 fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), as approved by the Grant County Quorum
- 27 Court.
- 28 (B) The Grant County District Court Clerk shall receive an
- 29 annual salary of not less than twenty-one thousand dollars (\$21,000) nor more
- 30 than thirty-six thousand dollars (\$36,000), as approved by the Grant County
- 31 Ouorum Court.
- 32 (C) The district court judge's and district court clerk's
- 33 salary shall be paid as follows:
- 34 (i) Twenty-seven percent (27%) to be paid by the
- 35 City of Sheridan; and
- 36 (ii) Seventy-three percent (73%) to be paid by Grant

2 (33) The Greene County District Court - Paragould District Clerk 3 shall receive an annual salary of not less than nineteen thousand eight 4 hundred fifty-six dollars (\$19,856) nor more than forty thousand dollars 5 (\$40,000), the chief deputy district court clerk shall receive an annual 6 salary of not less than sixteen thousand six hundred twenty-four dollars 7 (\$16,624) nor more than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000), and the 8 deputy district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than 9 thirteen thousand three hundred fourteen dollars (\$13,314) nor more than thirty-two thousand dollars (\$32,000).  - (93) The White County District Court Beebe Department Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-five thousand two hundred ten dollars (\$25,210) nor more than forty thousand nine hundred ninety dollars (\$40,990);
 - (94) The Woodruff County District Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000) nor more than thirty-six thousand dollars (\$36,000);
 - annual salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000). The district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand nine hundred twenty-six dollars (\$10,926) nor more than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000). The salaries shall be determined by the City of Wrightsville Board of Directors;
 - (96) The Yell County District Court Northern District Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand one hundred six

- dollars (\$10,106) nor more than twenty-one thousand six hundred forty-three dollars (\$21,643), as determined by the Yell County Quorum Court; and
- 3 (97) The Yell County District Court Southern District Judge 4 shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand one hundred six 5 dollars (\$10,106) nor more than twenty-one thousand six hundred forty-three 6 dollars (\$21,643), as determined by the Yell County Quorum Court.
- 7 (b)(1) The Elkins District Court Judge, Fayetteville District Court 8 Judge, Prairie Grove District Court Judge, Springdale District Court Judge, 9 and West Fork District Court Judge, at the request of the Washington County 10 Circuit Court and with the consent of the respective district court judges, 11 may perform certain functions as a judicial officer and as authorized by the 12 Arkansas Rules of Criminal Procedure or may perform certain pretrial functions, including, but not limited to, conducting pretrial release 13 14 inquiries, making reasonable cause determinations, accepting pleas of not 15 guilty or not guilty by reason of insanity, and issuing search warrants,
- 17 (2) Additional compensation in excess of the salary provided in 18 this section may be paid and must be approved by appropriation ordinances of 19 the engaging county quorum court.
 - (c) The local salary supplement paid to a district court judge under § 16-17-115(c) shall not be used when calculating the salary established in this section.
