1	(ii) An unmanned aircraft system used by the federal
2	government or a person who is acting pursuant to contract with the federal
3	government to conduct surveillance of specific critical infrastructure;
4	(iii) An unmanned aircraft system used by the state
5	after consultation with the Governor or a person who is acting under contract
6	with the state to conduct surveillance of specific critical infrastructure;
7	<u>or</u>
8	(iv)(a) An unmanned aircraft system used pursuant to
9	prior written authorization of the Arkansas Department of Emergency
10	Management.
11	(b) The department shall provide standards for
12	authorizations under subdivision (a)(1)(B)(iv)(a) of this section in rules
13	adopted in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201, et
14	seq., after consultation with the Governor; and
15	(2) "Critical infrastructure" means:
16	(A) An electrical power generation or delivery system;
17	(B) A petroleum refinery;
18	(C) A chemical or rubber manufacturing facility; or
19	(D) A petroleum or chemical storage facility.
20	(b) A person commits the offense of unlawful use of an unmanned
21	aircraft system if he or she knowingly uses an unmanned aircraft system to
22	conduct surveillance of, gather evidence or collect information about, or
23	photographically or electronically record critical infrastructure without the
24	prior written consent of the owner of the critical infrastructure.
25	(c) This section does not prohibit:
26	(1)(A) A person from using an unmanned aircraft system to
27	conduct surveillance of, gather evidence or collect information about, or
28	photographically or electronically record his or her own property that is:
29	(i) Located on his or her own immovable property; or
30	(ii) Located on immovable property owned by another
31	person under a valid lease, servitude, right-of-way, right of use, permit,
32	license, or other right.
33	(B) A third person retained by the owner of the property
34	described in subdivision (c)(l)(A) of this section to conduct activities
35	described in subdivision (c)(1)(A) of this section is not prohibited under
36	this section from using an unmanned aircraft system to conduct the activities

1	described in subdivision (c)(l) of this section; or
2	(2) An insurance company or a person acting on behalf of an
3	insurance company from using an unmanned aircraft system for purposes of
4	underwriting an insurance risk or investigating damage to insured property.
5	(d) Unlawful use of unmanned aircraft system is:
6	(1) A Class B misdemeanor; or
7	(2) A Class A misdemeanor for a second or subsequent offense.
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9	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 118, is amended to add an
10	additional section to read as follows:
11	16-118-111. Civil actions for against operators of an unmanned
12	aircraft system.
13	A person who violates § 5-60-103 is also liable to the owner of the
14	critical infrastructure that is the subject of the violation as follows:
15	(1) Any actual damages sustained as a result of the violation,
16	or ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), whichever is greater;
17	(2) Three (3) times actual damages, or ten thousand dollars
18	(\$10,000), whichever is greater, in a case in which the violation resulted in
19	profit or monetary gain; and
20	(3) The costs of an action brought under this section, together
21	with reasonable attorney's fees as determined by the court.
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
