Arkansas Code § 6-20-604(b), concerning additional funding, 20 is amended to read as follows: 21 (b) A school district shall receive special needs funding under 22 subsection (c), (d), or (e) of this section if the school district meets the 23 requirements of subsection (c), (d), or (e), respectively, of this section 24 and if: the Department of Education verifies that the isolated school area in 25 the schools district continues to meet at least four (4) of the five (5) 26 criteria under § 6-20-601(a). 27 (1) The school district was consolidated or annexed or received 28 an annexed school under the Public Education Reorganization Act, § 6-13-1601 29 et seq.; (2) The local school district board of directors by majority vote 30 31 determines that the isolated school is so isolated that to combine its operation to one (1) school district campus would be impractical or unwise; 32 33 and (3) The isolated school or school district: 34 (A) Meets the requirements of § 6-20-601 and filed an 35 36 affidavit of isolated school status with the State Board of Education during

1 the consolidation or annexation process, and the facts of the affidavit are 2 verified by the state board or its designee; 3 (B) Meets the requirements of § 6-20-601 and filed an 4 affidavit of isolated school status with the state board after the 5 consolidation or annexation process or with regard to the 2006-2007 school year no later than June 1, 2006, and the facts of the affidavit are verified 6 7 by the state board or its designee; or 8 (C) Meets the requirements of § 6-20-601 but for the prior-9 year three-quarter average daily membership requirement of three hundred 10 fifty (350) students or fewer and filed an affidavit of isolated school 11 status with the state board after the consolidation or annexation process or 12 with regard to the 2006-2007 school year no later than June 1, 2006, and the 13 facts of the affidavit are verified by the state board or its designee. 14 15 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-20-604(e), concerning additional funding, 16 is amended to read as follows: 17 (e)(1) Except as provided in subdivision (e)(2) of this section, a (e) 18 \underline{A} school district meeting the requirements of subsection (b) of this section 19 shall receive an additional amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the per-20 student foundation funding amount under § 6-20-2305(a)(2) multiplied by the 21 prior-year three-quarter average daily membership of the isolated school area 22 to be used for the operation of the isolated school area if the school 23 district has school facilities open for kindergarten through grade twelve (K-24 12) in one (1) or more isolated school areas meeting the requirements of 25 subsection (b) of this section. 26 (2) A school district shall receive an additional amount equal to 27 ten percent (10%) of the per-student foundation funding amount under § 6-20-28 2305(a)(2) multiplied by the prior year three quarter average daily 29 membership of the isolated school area to be used for the operation of the isolated school area if: 30 31 (A) The school district has school facilities serving students in any grade in kindergarten through grade twelve (K-12) in one (1) 32 or more isolated school areas meeting the requirements of subsection (b) of 33 34 this section; and (B) The school district closed an isolated facility serving 35 36 students in grades seven through twelve (7-12).

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2	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 6-20-604(h)(2)(B), concerning additional		
3	funding, is amended to read as follows:		
4	(B) Funds distributed under subdivision (h)(2)(A) of this		
5	section shall be used by the school district only for transportation costs of		
6	the isolated school areas in the school district.		
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8	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 6-20-604(h)(3), concerning additional		
9	funding, is repealed.		
10	(3) Funding provided under this section is in addition to and in		
11	excess of the amount of funds necessary to provide an adequate education as		
12	required by the Arkansas Constitution and cannot be relied upon beyond the		
13	expiration date of an appropriation made for the purposes of this section.
