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1	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
2	12-13-117. Review of fire protection class code determinations by
3	advisory organizations — Recommendations to Insurance Commissioner.
4	(a) The State Fire Marshal Enforcement Section may review fire
5	protection standards filings filed by an advisory organization with the
6	Insurance Commissioner if:
7	(1) The filing is based on the effectiveness of fire protection
8	services; and
9	(2) Upon request of the Insurance Commissioner or a person
10	affected by a rate filing.
11	(b) The State Fire Marshall Enforcement Section shall review a fire
12	protection class code determination by:
13	(1) Reassessing the fire protection services of each area of the
14	state under approved standards to determine whether or not the analysis of
15	the area's fire protection services were graded accurately considering the
16	area's concerns, characteristics, and equipment and support available for
17	fire protection services;
18	(2) Advising the commissioner if the fire protection class code
19	determination is reasonable and appropriate; and
20	(3) Recommending further review or action by the commissioner
21	concerning the fire protection class code determination.
22	(c) A recommendation by the State Fire Marshal Enforcement Section is
23	not binding on the commissioner.
24	(d) The State Fire Marshal Enforcement Section shall make its
25	recommendations under this section to the commissioner within thirty (30)
26	days after receipt of a request to review a fire protection standards filing.
27	(e) The State Fire Marshal Enforcement Section shall draw upon the
28	experience and knowledge of different individuals in this state to make an
29	informed recommendation to the commissioner.
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31	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 23-67-218(b), concerning records and
32	reports of advisory organizations, is amended to read as follows:
33	(b) <u>(1)</u> The commissioner may designate one (1) or more <u>an</u> advisory
34	organizations <u>organization</u> to assist him or her <u>the commissioner</u> in
35	gathering, compiling, and reporting the information.
36	<u>(2)</u> No <u>An</u> insurer shall be <u>is not</u> required to record or report

4	standards previously approved if filed by an advisory organization.
